Absolute; I am He, I am He. (Shivoham, Shivoham).

I am neither the materials of the body, nor the five
sheaths;

senses;

Nor was I ever born, nor had I parents, friends, and
relations;
I have neither Guru, nor disciple;
I am Existence Absolute, Knowledge Absolute, Bliss
Absolute; I am He, I am He. (Shivoham, Shivoham).



Stanza 6



अहं निर्विकल्पो निराकाररूपो
विभूर्व्याप्य सर्वत्र सर्वन्द्रियाणि ।
सदा मे समत्वं न मुक्तिर्न बन्धः
चिदानन्दरूपः शिवोऽहं शिवोऽहम् ॥६



I am untouched by the senses, I am neither Mukti nor knowable;
I am without form, without limit, beyond space, beyond time;
I am in everything; I am the basis of the universe; everywhere am I.
I am Existence Absolute, Knowledge Absolute, Bliss Absolute; I am He, I am He. (Shivoham, Shivoham).

Strength, strength is what the Upanishads speak to me from every page.
