

Kalash and Kalash Puja

A Hindu Temple begins with the foundation and continues in height up to the Kalash (pinnacle). The Kalash is a pointed dome at the top and is of religious significance. In ancient times, the rishis of India placed copper pots atop temple pinnacles to escape the calamity of lightning. But fungus developed on the pots and reduced their efficiency and so they gold-enameled the pots with gold.

The rishis wanted water all year round to quench their thirst, so they developed a container- a Kalash and they were happy that they could enshrine God Varun in the Kalash and thus the worship of Varun started with the worship of Kalash. According to Indian mythology, the mouth of the Kalash represnts Vishnu, the throat-Lord Shiva, Lord Brahma adores the base and at the belly all Goddesses are established and thus in a small pot they established the presence of all Gods and Goddesses.

In India, on most of the ceremonial occasions, a pot filled with clean water, with fresh mango or betel leaves placed at the mouth and a coconut placed on top, is kept near the entrance. It is also decorated with Swastik symbol and other ornamentations.

Puja is done to earth and soil is collected in a clay pot to be taken to the yagashala

Vastu Puja is performed in honor of Vastu Purusha and for his ceremonious eviction from the temple. After the puja, Vastu Purusha is invoked in the havan and aahutis offered to him. Following this Vastu Purusha is extracted out of the homo gunda, taken around the hall and finally thrown outside the temple. Bali(food) is placed outside the temple for Vastu Purusha's later use. Vastu Purusha has the boon from Almighty to inhabit new buildings. He has an insatiable hunger and he should be evicted. If this is not done, he would engulf everything. Operating a temple, home or business with Vastu Purusha in it is like driving a car with a hole in fuel line.
