Janamashtami- Sri Krishna's Birthday

Lord Krishna was born in Dwapar Yug which came just before the Kalvug and Janamashtami. His birthday falls on the Ashtami Paksh or the 8th day of the new moon fortnight in the month of Bhadra some time in July or August. Sri Krishna, the ninth incarnation of Lord Vishnu is the most popular avtar and is regarded as purna avtar. All other deities are regarded as his manifestations. To the Hindu, he is the supreme statesman, warrior, hero, philosopher, teacher and God himself.

According to the legends, the birth of Lord Krishna took place under extraordinary circumstances. Krishna was an incarnation of Lord Vishnu who came to the world to get rid of all evil demons. He was born at midnight sroke on a dark, rainy night to Devaki and Vasudev who had been imprisoned by Devaki's brother Kansa. It had been foretold that the eighth son of Devaki would kill the evil king Kansa. Upon hearing this prophecy, Kansa had his sister put in prison. He killed her seven children one by one but when Krishna was born there was divine intervention to save the life of baby Krishna. He was raised in Vrindavan by Yashoda and Nanda.

Krishna as a young man returned to Mathura, overthrew his uncle Kansa, and became the ruler of the Yadavas at Mathura. His story and his exploits (leela) are numerous and very well known.

Janamashtami is a festival dedicated to Lord Krishna and commemorates his birth.

GOPI GEET LECTURE SERIES

(Gopi Virah Vedana Geet)

Shrinathaji Seva Group of our Temple is pleased to arrange a Satsang on Gopi Geet as a three lectures seminar by our Panditji Shri Kailash Sharma. All devotees and especially those of Radha-Krishna will enjoy listening to verses of the Gopi Geet and an elaborate explanation of the inner meaning of the Gopis' cries ("virah vedana") for Krishna.

We believe many of us have not heard a detailed discussion on Gopi Geet in Cincinnati. Our Panditji has graciously agreed to do Satsang with us and share with us Bhakti Rasa that Krishna's Gopis have expressed via this beautiful and uplifting spiritual composition from Shrmad Bhagavat. We hope you will make time to attend this Satsang. Below is some more information on Gopi Geet.

Gopi Geet is part of Srimad Bhagavat. It is contained in the first half of book ten, chapter 31, verses 1 to 19 of Bhagavat Purana. In these nineteen tender verses, Gopis, female consort of Lord Krishna, narrate his glory at the time of his disappearance during the Rāsa play. Sri Krishna planned $R\bar{a}sa\ lil\bar{a}$ to lift Gopis to a higher spiritual state. However, Lord Krishna was perturbed by the introvert pursuit of Gopis and in order to teach them a lesson, he disappeared deep into the forest. When Gopis did not find Krishna, they became breathless. Bemused Gopis looked all over, but in vain. Then, with their body, mind and soul in unison with Krishna's memories, they arrived at the banks of river Yamuna. Immersed in his unfathomable love and earnestly longing for his heavenly vision, Gopis' started singing the glory of his divine grace and the very tunes became known as Gopi Geet - cries for Krishna.

"O beloved! Please reveal Yourself and see how your sweethearts, who have centered their life around you, are longing for you... You have saved us time and again from death through poisonous water, from the clutches of demon disguised as a snake and in the form of a calf, from showers and storm, from strokes of lightning, from all sort of menaces... We believe that You are not merely son of a cowherd woman but essence of all embodied souls... You have manifested for the protection of the universe... O beloved! Our mind grows uneasy thinking about your lotus-feet getting pricked with blades of grass and sprouts when You go out pasturing the cattle... Our minds are infatuated and we are longing to be one with You. Please appear before us."




