

The Gist of The Bhagavadgeeta By Mr. Koti Sree Krishna

Gita (3136 BC), the longest philosophical song (700 verses) in the world literature is perhaps the most popular of the Hindu scriptures. It is considered as the essence of the Vedanta Philosophy (Upanishads). Gita was delivered, over 5000 years ago in the month of Margashirsha (Nov-Dec) by Krishna to Arjuna in the great Mahabharatha war (battle field of Kurukshaetra). The essential teachings of Gita are as follows:

- *God is the source of everything.
- *The best in everything and everyone is God.
- *God is omnipotent and omnipresent.
- *True knowledge is to know God.
- *Death is only to body. The Soul is ever alive. The soul takes new bodies until it is liberated. The simplest path is that of total surrender to the supreme.
- *Once we surrender to God, our soul is free from cycles of birth and death.
- *The good wins over the evil with God's help.
- *God reincarnates, as needed to establish righteousness (**dharma**) and punish the wicked. There is no number, form or space limitation to incarnations (**avatArs**).
- *The form of God we sincerely worship, in that very form God cements our faith.
- *All pray to the same one God.
- *True believers of God never fall.
- *Action is inevitable. No one can exist without performing action. Our basic nature and sense organs drive us to action.
- * Saintly (sAtvik), showy(rAjasik) and lazy (tAmasik) are basic human nature (guNa). Try to become more saintly in thoughts, words, and deed(including eating habits, leisure activities, charitable work, etc.). Better yet, go beyond basic nature (become a guNAteeta).
- * Raise above the differences of pain and pleasure, good and bad, victory and defeat, etc. (become a **dvandvAtIta**)
- * Work without greed. Don't be lazy. Do the work that suits you best.
- * Five factors determine outcome of actions: Situation, tools, effort, doer and providence.
- *Dedicate all your actions and their fruits to God. That is true renunciation (sanyAs).
- *Share your fortunes with others, otherwise you will be nothing but a thief.
- *Always protect **dharma** (support what is right).
- *Follow moderation. Maintain a good balance of work, rest, food and pleasure.
- *Be an example for good.
- *Be humble and tolerant.
- *Lust, anger, and greed lead to sorrow.
- *Love (faith), light (knowledge) and life (work) are the ways to God.
- *Love all beings. See ONE in all and all in ONE.
- *You are your best friend and your worst enemy.
- *Only few people truly realize the truth.
- *December is Lord Krishna's favorite month and Spring is His favorite season.
- *Easy to please God. Just offer some water, or a flower, or a leaf with faith or just think of God.
- *Wisdom (Krishna) plus Action (Arjuna) equals Success.
- *The greatest Mantra is **Om** (AUM)
