#### Ma Saraswati

Saraswati is the Goddess of learning, knowledge, and wisdom. The Sanskrit word sara means "essence" and swa means "self." Thus Saraswati means "the essence of the self." Saraswati is represented in Hindu mythology as the divine consort of Lord Brahma, the Creator of the universe. Since knowledge is necessary for creation, Saraswati symbolizes the creative power of Brahma. Goddess Saraswati is worshipped by all persons interested in knowledge, especially students, teachers, scholars, and scien-

In Her popular images and pictures, Goddess Saraswati is generally depicted with four arms (some pictures may show only two arms), wearing a white sari and seated on a white lotus. She holds a book and a rosary in Her rear two hands, while the front two hands are engaged in the playing of a veena. Her right leg is shown slightly pushing against Her left leg. She uses a swan as Her vehicle. There is a peacock by Her side gazing at Her. This symbolism illustrates the following spiritual ideas:

The lotus is a symbol of the Supreme Reality, and a white lotus also denotes supreme knowledge. By sitting on a lotus, Saraswati signifies that She is Herself rooted in the Supreme Reality, and symbolizes supreme knowledge. The white color symbolizes purity and knowledge. The white sari that the Goddess is wearing denotes that She is the embodiment of pure knowledge.

The four arms denote Her omnipresence and omnipotence. The two front arms indicate Her activity in the physical world and the two back arms signify Her presence in the spiritual world. The four hands represent the four elements of the inner personality. The mind (manas) is represented by the front right hand, the intellect (buddhi) by the front left hand, the conditioned consciousness (chitta) by the rear left hand, and the ego (ahankara) by the rear right hand. The left side of the body symbolizes the qualities of the heart and the right side symbolizes activities of the mind and intellect. A book in the rear left hand signifies that knowledge acquired must be used with love and kindness to promote prosperity of mankind.



Secretary opened the meeting with a warm welcome to all those present at the meeting. Agenda items were read as published. No new agenda items were added from the floor.EC members introduced themselves.

1--President's Report: President started by welcoming every one to the meeting. He gave an overview of the accomplishments during the year 2005.

a---A new house has been purchased, primarily to provide a second access route to the temple property. This was in the works for almost 10 years. Master Plan approved by general body about 10 years ago was contingent upon this purchase and now can move forward as the time and resources permit.

b---North. South and East Wings of the temple have been completed.

- c---The Temple has been newly painted, both on the inside as well as outside.
- d---The community is working together again. He mentioned the cultural festivals such as Dewali and Garbha being held at one place rather than separately.
- e---The occupancy permit has been issued by the county and received by the secretary. It will be placed in the temple office.
- f---President also praised many unsung heroes who keep on volunteering their time without any expectations for recognition.

He said that he is leaving with sweet memories and will continue to be involved.

2--Treasurer's Report: Treasurer distributed an Income and Expense Report. This report covered a period from January 1, 2005 through November 30, 2005.

No project is started unless funds are available to complete the project.

3—Secretary's Report: Secretary stated that as indicated by the president a number of things have been accomplished, however, a lot needs to be done. Existing volunteers are doing a good job; however, temple needs new volunteers. The involvement of new people is very important for the long term welfare of the temple. Volunteers are needed in many areas.

Constitution needs to be changed for both substance and clarification

- 1—Board of Trustees was approved by the executive council and details are being worked out by a committee for approval by the general membership of Hindu Society in 2006. This will require a constitutional amendment.
- 2—quorum requirement are difficult to meet if not impossible. This requirement needs to be reviewed and changed if approved by the General membership.
- 3—Clarification of certain items: Are executive council members allowed to serve three years or four years continuously without a break in service?
- 4---Long range Planning Committee Report---The President read a letter from the chair person, who was out of the country.

A new community Center (CC) has been proposed to be build at the Hindu Temple complex consisting of about 20,000 square feet area.. Estimated seating capacity is more than 900 people.

Estimated cost is \$ 1.2 million. Initial fund raising drive is expected to generate about \$ 200,000 to \$ 400,000 and the rest will be borrowed. Chair Person of Long Range Committee (Jitu Bhai Patel) will lead the efforts to build the Community Center.

A detailed analysis of the community Center project is needed. This will require a more detailed plan preparation, cost estimates, site selection, approval from the county; negotiations with a bank for a loan Etc; to accomplish this work will cost money.

Thus it was duly proposed by Mr. Laxmi Srivastava and seconded by Mr. Amar Sharma that EC should spend funds to perform detailed analysis with the help of professionals. The larger community will be kept advised as the details become available Via Hindu Society news letter (Aradhana) and/or special news letter. The project is expected to come for approval before the General body towards the end of March.

5—Elections for the new EC members were conducted. All EC members were elected unopposed as follows:

5---Some people asked general questions and made comments which are summarized as follows:

Q-what is the location of the new house purchased by the Hindu Society.

A—Address of the house is in the office for those who want to check it.

Q---How many EC members attended all twelve EC meetings?

- A---If Quorum is present then an issue is decided. If quorum is not present then the issue is postponed until later.
- Q---How do you decide type of membership when a person donates money to the temple?
- A---At the present time it is decided by the office manager. He makes a judgment.
- Comments: Can not make voluntary decision on membership, need to develop a system.
- Q---Who is responsible for membership and how many members do you have?
- A----Membership and fundraising Chairperson is responsible for the membership and he keeps track of it.

Membership and Fundraising chair person does not have a key to the office and access to the computer at this time. Arrangements will be made.


#### Ma Saraswati

The rosary signifies concentration, meditation, and contemplation, leading to samadhi, or union with God. A rosary in the rear right hand representing ego conveys that true knowledge acquired with love and devotion melts the ego and results in liberation (moksha) of the seeker from the bondage to the physical world.

The Goddess is shown playing a musical instrument that is held in Her front hands, which denote mind and intellect. This symbol conveys that the seeker must tune his mind and intellect in order to live in perfect harmony with the world. Such harmonious living enables the individual to utilize acquired knowledge for the welfare of all mankind.

Two swans are depicted on the left side of the Goddess. A swan is said to have a sensitive beak that enables it to distinguish pure milk from a mixture of milk and water. A swan, therefore, symbolizes the power of discrimination, or the ability to discriminate between right and wrong or good and bad. Saraswati uses the swan as Her carrier. This indicates that one must acquire and apply knowledge with discrimination for the good of mankind. Knowledge that is dominated by ego can destroy the world.

A peacock is sitting next to Saraswati and is anxiously waiting to serve as Her vehicle. A peacock depicts unpredictable behavior as its moods can be influenced by the changes in the weather. Saraswati is using a swan as a vehicle and not the peacock. This signifies that one should overcome fear, indecision, and fickleness in order to acquire true knowledge.
