### Significance of Garbha Griha in Temple By Pundit B.C. Sharma

'Garbha Griha' is a small square shaped sanctuary named as 'womb room' housing the main image or the Deity. It is conectd with adjoining pillared mandap. This whole sanctuary as a whole is called "a viman'. Inside the viman is a dark chamber which is called 'Garbha Griha'. The ceiling over it is usually shaped like an umbrella or like a lotus flower having eight petals known as 'The Aashta Dal Kamal'.

The developed different distinct regional variations can be visible in different provinces of India like in Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Orissa, Madhya Pradesh, and U.P. but the overall effect of harmony and majesty is maintained in the same way all over India. The sanctuary of the Sun Temple of Kanark which is badly damaged is one of the largest and the most famous in India.

The 'Garbha Griha' and 'Kalashas' are the most important features of the temple. The temple is not perfect and complete without each of them. The 'Kalash' is called 'Naadi' and 'Garbha Griha' is the womb house. The distance between the 'Kalash' and the womb room spot is measured, and based on the concept of 'Taal Maan'. The proportional length, breadth, and height of the womb house is planned and designed. The 'Pranas' are infused during the 'Murti Sthapna' function by Aacharyas and the priests, in the deities seated within the 'girbha griha'.


