### Gita Jayanti

Every year, the birth of Srimad Bhagwad Gita is celebrated as the Gita Jayanti, throughout India by all the admirers and lovers of this sacred scripture. It is celebrated on the eleventh day of the bright half of the month of Margaseersha (December-January). The event celebrates the treatise on 'karma' that Lord Krishna, the main protagonist of the epic, delivered to Arjun in the divine moment.

Mythology has it, that Kurukshetra was witness to the Mahabharata battle fought between the Pandavas and the Kauravas. In the battle of right versus wrong, Lord Krishna was the charioteer of Arjun. As the forces came to stand before each other, Arjun was filled with anguish. His brothers, kith and kin stood against each other for battle. At that point of time, Lord Krishna delivered the celestial song of Gita Updesh, the path of selfless 'Karma' (action), 'Gyana' (knowledge), and single-hearted devotion to the Lord, to the wavering Arjun. Krishna counsels Arjun with the tenet that the soul is both eternal and immortal. Any death on the battlefield would involve only the shedding of the body, but the inner soul is permanent.

The Gita shows a way to rise above the world of duality and the pairs of opposites, and to acquire eternal bliss and immortality. It teaches the rigid performance of one's duty in society, and a life of active struggle, keeping the inner being untouched by outer surroundings, and renouncing the fruits of actions as offerings unto the Lord. The Gita is a source of power and wisdom. It teaches you to embrace righteousness and to resist unrighteousness.

### The Bhagavad Gita

The Bhagavad Gita is also called Gitopanisad implying it to be an Upanishad. The Bhagavad Gita comprises of 700 verses of the Mahabharata. The content of the Bhagavad Gita is a conversation between Krishna and Arjuna taking place in the battlefield of Kurukshetra just prior to the start of a war. Responding to Arjuna's confusion and moral dilemma, Krishna explains to Arjuna his duties and elaborates on a number of different yogic and Vedantic philosophies. This has led to the Gita often being described as a guide to Hindu philosophy.

The Gita addresses the discord between the senses and the intuition of cosmic order. It speaks of the Yoga of equanimitty, a detached outlook. The term Yoga covers a wide range of meanings, but in the context of the Bhagavad Gita, describes a unified outlook, serenity of mind, skill in action, and the ability to stay attuned to the glory of the Self (Atman), which is of the same essence as the basis of Being (Brahman). According to Krishna, the root of all suffering and discord is the agitation of the mind caused by selfish desire. The only way to douse the flame of desire is by simultaneously stilling the mind through self discipline and engaging oneself in a higher form of activity. However, abstinence from action is regarded as being just as detrimental as extreme indulgence. According to the Bhagavad Gita, the goal of life is to free the mind and intellect from their complexities, and to focus them on the glory of the Self, by dedicating one's actions to the divine. This goal can be achieved through the Yogas of meditation, action, devotion and knowledge. The Gita describes the best Yogi as one who constantly contemplates God. There are four kinds of Yoga - Raja Yoga or Psycho-Physical Meditation, Bhakti Yoga or Devotion, Karma Yoga or Selfless Action, and Jnana Yoga or Self Transcending Knowledge.

While each path differs, their fundamental goal is the same - to realize Brahman(the Divine Essence ) as being the ultimate truth upon which our material universe rests, that the body is temporal, and that the Supreme Soul (Paramatma) is infinite. Yoga's aim (moksha) is to escape from the cycle of reincarnation through realization of the ultimate reality. There are three stages to self-realisation enunciated from the Bhagavad Gita:

- 1. Brahman The impersonal universal energy
- 2. Paramatma The Supreme Soul sitting in the heart of every living entity.
- 3. Bhagavan God as a personality, with a transcendental form.

Below are quotations from Krishna concerning Bhakti Yoga of the Bhagavad Gita:


#### On The Goal Of Yoga

" And whoever, at the time of death, quits his body, remembering Me (Krishna) alone, at once attains My (Krishna's- Transcendental) nature. Of this there is no doubt."

### On Bhakti Yoga

Put simply, Bhakti Yoga is Service in Love and Devotion to God (Krishna in the context of the Bhagavad Gita). "I consider the Yogi-devotee - who lovingly contemplates on Me with supreme faith, and whose mind is ever absorbed in Me - to be the best of all the Yogis". "After attaining Me, the great souls do not incur rebirth in this miserable transitory world, because they have attained the highest perfection." "... those who, renouncing all actions in Me, and regarding Me as the Supreme, worship Me... For those whose thoughts have entered into Me, I am soon the deliverer from the ocean of death and transmigration, Arjuna. Keep your mind on Me alone, your intellect on Me. Thus you shall dwell in Me hereafter." "And he who serves Me with the yoga of unswerving devotion, transcending these qualities [binary opposites, like good and evil, pain and pleasure] is ready for liberation in Brahman." "Fix your mind on Me, be devoted to Me, offer service to Me, bow down to Me, and you shall certainly reach Me. I promise you because you are My very dear friend." "Setting aside all meritorious deeds (Dharma), just completely to My will (with firm faith and loving contemplation). I shall liberate you from all sins. Do not fear."
