Adhik-Maas (Additional Month) Purushottam Maas

Some part of the world follow solar calendar and the other part of the world follow lunar calendar.

The lunar calendar, which is believed to have originated in India, has been followed by Hindus for a very long time, even long before the solar calendar. The lunar calendar is based on the moon's rotation around the earth. The lunar month corresponds to the one complete rotation of the moon around the earth. Since this period of rotation of the moon around the earth varies, the duration of the lunar month also varies.

Astronomical calculation

The lunar calendar adds one extra month about every third year. This extra month is known by various names: Adhik Maas, Mal Maas, Purushottam Maas, Malimmacha. This is the thirteenth, the additional or surplus, month of the lunar calendar. The solar year is made up of 365.2422 days and the lunar year is made up of 354.372 days. Thus the gap between the solar year and the lunar year is 11 days, 1 hour, 31 minutes and 12 seconds. As this gap increases each year, in less than three years it approximates to one month. According to Vasishtha Siddhanta (the treatise of Vasishtha) the Adhik (additional or surplus) Maas or extra lunar month occurs every 32 months, 16 days and 8 Ghadis (a Ghadi equals to 24 minutes and 60 Ghadis equal 24 hours). Now, the moon takes about 27.3 days to make one complete orbit around the earth. The earth orbits around the sun once every 365.2422 days at an orbital speed of 29.79 km per second. The earth and the moon in 27.3 days have moved as a system (i.e. moon orbiting the earth and both together orbiting the sun) about 1/12th of the ways around the sun. This means that from one full moon to the next full moon, the moon must travel 2.2 extra days before it appears full. This is due to the curve of the earth's orbit around the sun.





The moon is still making one complete orbit around the earth (circle) in 27.3 days. But to line up with the earth and sun to become a full moon again it takes 29.531 days. 29.531 day of each twelve Lunar months (29.531times 12) = 354.372 days per lunar year. Thus we arrive at a difference of about 10.87 days a year between a lunar year and a solar year. To be exact, a lunar year is 11 days, 1 hour and 31 minutes shorter than a solar year. To balance out this difference between these two systems (calendars) our far-sighted Astronomer Rishi-Munis calculated and facilitated this extra lunar month or Adhik Maas. They specially awarded the month by proclaiming it as a 'Pious Month'. Complicated as this is, let's just say that the Adhik Maas or Purushottam Mahino balances the lunar and solar calendars

Religious significance of Adhik Maas

As mentioned before, Adhik Maas or Mal Maas is also known as Purushottama Maas. There is a story in **Puran** about this. According to it there were originally 12 months in lunar year. But later on one extra month was added to it. Each of the twelve months was assigned to 12 different gods so that the lunar and the solar years do not get out of step with days and seasons. But one problem still remained. The 13th extra month was not assigned to any god. Adhik Maas (Mal Maas) felt sadden and approached Lord Vishnu and said that no god was assigned to him and for that reason he was called Mal Maas (dirty month) or Malimmucha. Adhik Maas. He further spoke to Lord Vishnu: "I am filled with anxiety and I have therefore come to seek your refuge and help."

Lord Vishnu took pity on him. The Lord (Vishnu) agreed and assigned Adhik Maas to Himself and gave the name **Purushottama Maas** to this month. The Lord further stated: "Whosoever shall pray, fast, chant, sing, worship during the month of Purushottam, will be specially blessed, and get maximum recognition by me." Since then it became known as the Purushottama Maas and acquired greater significance than the other months. It is written in the **Bhavishyottar Purana** that fasting or eating once a day should commence on the first day of the bright fortnight (Shukla Paksha) and end on the last day of the dark fortnight (Krishna Paksha). According to ability, distribute to charities and do good deeds.

According to **Devi Bhagavat,** charitable and meritorious acts and fasting etc. carried out during this Adhik Maas, inevitably produce results. Just as microscopic contents within a seed produce a giant and long living Banyan tree, in the same manner even a little charitable act done during Adhik Maas produces big results

Hemadri says that Adhik Maas Vrat is capable of washing away all the sins of people (who observe the Vrat). During this month Vrat, Japa, fasting etc. are undertaken and food and clothing etc. are distributed to charities. A beautiful story relates to how, in ancient times, through the observance of Mal Maas Vrat, **king Nahush** was released from all bondage and acquired the throne of Indra (the ruler of gods in heaven).

The Vedas call upon the world habitants again and again to re-unite with the spiritual entity of one's Prakruti. Here the Prakruti means five fundamental elements (matters) of the composition of a human body. These five matter are namely earth, water, fire, air, and ether plus the mind-Mann, the intellect-Buddhi; the ego-Aham and the divine soul– Atman. Purushottama Maas is the month during which the humankind is privileged to become divinely spiritual.

This is the month of self-development, self-revaluations, self-assessment, self-reflection, and self-retrospection. It is a time for one's own spiritual development and progress. We pray that there is abundance and no shortage of grains, wealth and that the pollution be extinguished by the powers of Varuna, the God of compassion and waters and Vayau, the wind god.

God grant us the serenity to accept all those yesterdays and all those things that make us sad and hurtful. God grant us the courage and the divine strength to change and alter those issues that we can change today to make our tomorrow a better life, a better hope, and a better love. Love is all that matters. Love is all that there is in life to give and love is all one truly needs. 

Nirjala Ekadashi

Acharya Kailash Sharma

Ekadashi the eleventh day, is considered a sacred day. It is believed that loads of negative karmic reactions are removed when fasting, prayer and meditation is observed on this day. In every month of the year there are two Ekadashis. One is in Krishn Paksha (dark fortnight) and the other in Shukla Paksha (bright fortnight). Each Ekadadhi has its own legend and all Ekadashis have their special name as follows: 1. Kamda. 2. Varuthini 3. Mohini 4. Apra 5.Kamla 6.Nirjala 7.Yogini 8.DevShayani 9.Kamika 10.Pavitra 11.Aja. 12. Jaljhulni. 13. Indira 14.Paapankusha 15.Rma 16. Pravodhini 17. Utpatti 18. Mokshda 19.Shattilla 20.Jaya 21.Vijaya 22.Aamlaki 23.Paapmochini 24.Vaikuntha. In all, 24 Ekadashi fasts are observed in a year but there are some Ekadashis which have greater significance and importance than the others.

According to Bhavishya Puran Ekadashi is the daughter of Bahgwan Vishnu. In Satyug period there was a Demon called Mur who was troubling all the Devtas. They went to Lord Vishnu for help. Lord Vishnu fought with Mur but couldn't kill him as he was protected by the blessing of Lord Brahma. Then from Lord Vishnu's power emerged a young lady whom He named Uttapati. Mur was attracted by her beauty but she fought with him and killed him. Lord Vishnu told her that you have saved all Devatas. I am very pleased with you. What can I give to you? She asked three boons that I be always your beloved, I be in all the tithes and whoever observes fast and performs worship this day must get success and reach to Vaikuntha (The abode of Vishnu)

Nirjala Ekadashi is one of the more auspicious one. It falls on Jyeshtha Shukla 11th day of the bright fortnight (May or June. This year it is on June 26th Tuesday). Nir means without and Jala means water. Not only people refrain from taking food but also water.

The Vrat of Nirjala Ekadashi is described and illustrated in the Mahabharat and Padma Puran

Once Bhim asked Vyasji, "O Muni, My mother Kunti, all my brothers, Draupadi and all members of the family follow and keep the vrat of Ekadashi by having a full fast and abstaining from food and water on the days of Ekadashi. But O Muniraj, I cannot do such kinds of vrat because I cannot bear the pain of hunger even for a second. O Muni, to leave alone abstaining from food the whole day is one thing. I cannot even tolerate not eating once a day. O Vyasji, please show me a way out so that I can observe the Vrat of Ekadashi and could eat at the same time."

The great Acharya Vyasji replied, "O Bhim, on the day of Nirjala Ekadashi one has to go without food and water totally to keep the vrat and attain its fruits (results). One should not even take any kind of fruits, nuts or any kind of vegetation on this day. The Vrat should commence from sunrise of this day until the sunrise of the next day. One must perform continuous devotion to God Almighty the full day and carry on to the night for Jagran. On the following day, the Vrat should be completed by a morning bath and donating food and water to the Brahmins.

O Bhim, pursuing the vrat of Nirjala Ekadashi gives a soul great benefit. It equates the fruits to visiting great holy pilgrims, removes the fear of death, and gives ultimate salvation. O Bhim, one must go through the pain of hunger on this Vrat and control all the bodily senses and unite them with devotion to God."

After the explanation Bhim and the rest of the Pandavas observed the Vrat of Nirjala Ekadashi, with full devotion to God Almighty. Therefore this Ekadashi is also known as Pandava Ekadashi or Bhimsen Ekadashi. The main purpose of observing this or any kind of Vrats is to control our senses and concentrate on God.

'Aum Namo Bagwate Vaasdevaya' this mantra should be chanted as much as possible.


