



#### Jagannath Swamy Nayana Pathagami Bhabatume

The **Ratha Yatra festival** comes in the rainy season, during the months of June and July. This is the most special event in Puri. Puri, also known as Srikshetra or Jagannathadham, is in the state of Orissa. The Ratha Yatra is held in honor of Lord Jagannath, whose name literally means the Lord of the Universe.

There is a huge temple of Jagannath in Puri. It is one of the four major traditional centers (or Dham) of pilgrimage in India. The temple of **Lord Jagannath** enshrines wooden images of Lord Jagannath (Krishna), his elder brother Balaram or Balabhadra and his sister Subhadra. This massive temple was built nearly eight centuries ago.

The Jagannath temple was originally built by the Kalinga ruler, Anantavarman Chodaganga (1078 - 1148 AD). Much of the present structure was built by King Ananga Bhima Deva in the year 1174 AD. It took 14 years to complete and was sanctified in 1198 AD. It is believed that in that time, the image of Jagannath was buried thrice in the Chilka lake for protection from invaders.

The deities always stand in a row. The fair-colored Balaram, stands on the left. Dark-colored Krishna or Jagannath is on the right and the yellow-colored sister Subhadra is in the center. These deities represent a closely knit Hindu family. Hindus make pilgrimages to Jagannath temple all the year round but it is considered to be very special if the pilgrimage is made during Ratha Yatra.

The Ratha Yatra festival attracts **millions of people** from all over the world. The most impressive part of the festival is the chariot procession. Three richly decorated chariots, resembling temple structures, are pulled through the streets of Puri. Each of the three deities, Jagannath, Balaram and Subhadra are seated in their own chariot. New chariots are built every year. New deities, however, are carved every twelve years. The deities are carved from the trunk of a *neem* tree which is common in India. The *neem* tree is a hard wood tree and has great medicinal value. On the day of the Ratha Yatra, Hindu children in the eastern part of India go out onto the streets with small chariots, which symbolize the big festival of Puri. During the festival, devotees from all over India go to Puri with an earnest desire to touch the rope of the chariot. They consider this a pious deed and risk their lives in the huge crowd. The huge processions accompanying the chariots play devotional songs with drums, tambourines, etc. Children line the streets through which the chariot will pass and add to the mass chorus. Temporary stalls of food, toys, Ferris wheels and other attractions are also set up.

In the Jagannath Puri festival, the **king works as a sweeper**, cleaning the pathway ahead of the chariot, showing that even a king has a duty to work for God. People from all communities get together to draw the chariots with great enthusiasm, upholding the spirit of celebration and exalting the concept of dignity of labor.

The deities are unusual. They are unfinished. The hands are short and their lower parts are incomplete. The legend associated with the unusual appearance of the deities may interest you.

Orissa was formerly known as **Utkal**. A long time ago, there was a King named Indradyumna who ruled over Utkal. He had a long cherished desire to build a temple but debated in his mind about the deity. One day he dreamt of a blue-colored Krishna, called Neelamadhaba located in a cave of Nilachal Hill. Much of India at that time was covered with forests. No one knew for sure the location of Nilachal Hill. King Indradyumna sent his messengers in all directions until one of them, Vidyapati, found the cave and saw the image of Neelamadhaba. The king acquired the image and became very proud for his achievement. This lack of humility in him made the deity disappear.

The king repented and prayed constantly. One day, he heard a voice in dream. The voice asked the king to search for a wooden trunk on the shore with which he could carve an idol. After a massive search, the trunk was found between two rocks. The trunk was then brought ashore for carving, but no one could make a scratch on it! The wood was as hard as granite.

One day a craftsman arrived from nowhere and told the king that he is willing to give a try. The king explained what he wanted and how the image of Neelamadhaba should appear. However, the craftsman had two conditions. First, he would not take any dictation on how the deity should appear and second, he would be allowed to work in a closed room for fifteen days without being disturbed. The king agreed to the craftsman's terms. The craftsman was none other than Lord Vishwakarma, the God of Craftsmanship.

After ten days, the queen became impatient. She tried to hear if anything was going on inside the closed room. The old man hadn't eaten for ten days and there was no sound coming from within. She tried repeatedly to convince the king to open the door and the king ultimately yielded. When they entered, the craftsman had already disappeared and the images were **incomplete**. The king was puzzled if the unfinished images should be enshrined. Suddenly at that time, a voice from above told the King that since he did not obey the condition by the craftsman (to not open the door) the craftsman left the deities unfinished. However, the deities could be worshipped. Finally, he did install the incomplete deities and worshipped them daily. These deities are the ones we know as Lord **Jagannath**, **Balabhadra**, and **Subhudra**.

The **first ever** Ratha Yatra celebrations at our Hindu Temple will be taking place on July 21 and 22<sup>nd</sup>. Please plan to attend this momentous occasion!




