GANESH CHATURTHI

Vakratunda mahakaya, suryakoti samprabha, | Nirvighnam kuru may dev, sarvakaryeshu sarvada ||



Ganesh Chaturthi is one of the major festivals. It is the birthday of Lord Ganesh. It falls on the 4th day of the bright fortnight of Bhadrapada (September). This year it is on Saturday, Sep.15th 2007. It is celebrated throughout India, as well as by devoted Hindus all over the world.

Every year clay figures of the Deity are made and after being worshipped for ten days, they are immerged into ocean or rivers. Lord Ganesh is the elephant-headed God. He is worshipped first in any prayers. His Names are chanted first before any auspicious work and any kind of worship is begun. He is the Lord of power and wisdom. He is the eldest son of Lord Shiva and the elder brother of Kartikeya...

The following story is narrated about His birth and how He came to have the head of an elephant. Once upon a time, the Goddess Parvati (consort of Lord Shiva), while bathing, created Ganesh from the mud of Her Body and placed Him at the entrance of the house. She told Him not to allow anyone to enter the house when she goes for a bath. One day When Lord Shiva Himself returned home and was stopped by Ganesh at the gate. Shiva became angry and cut off Ganesh's head as He thought Ganesh was a stranger. When Parvati came to know of this she was sorely grieved. To console her grief, Shiva ordered His Ganas (servents) to cut off and bring to Him the head of any creature that might be sleeping with its head facing north. The servants went on their mission and found only an elephant in that position. The sacrifice was thus made and the elephant's head was brought before Shiva. The Lord then joined the elephant's head onto the body of Ganesh.

Lord Shiva made His son worthy of worship at the beginning of all undertakings, marriages, all the worships, studies, etc. He ordained that the annual worship of Ganesh should take place on the 4th day of the bright half of Bhadrapada. Without the Grace of Shri Ganesh and His help nothing whatsoever can be achieved. No action can be undertaken without His support, Grace or blessing.

The following are some of the common Names of Lord Ganesh: Dhoomraketu, Sumukha, Ekadantha, Gajakarnaka, Lambodara, Vignaraja, Ganadhyaksha, Bhalachandra, Gajanana, Vinayaka, Vakratunda, Siddhivinayaka, Surpakarna, Heramba, Skandapurvaja, Kapila and Vigneshwara..The devotees of Ganesh chants Japa of the Ganesh Gayatri Mantra which is as follows.

Om ekdantaya vidmahe Vakratundaaya dheemahi, Tanno dhanti prachodayaat.

Lord Ganesh is an embodiment of wisdom and bliss. He has as his vehicle a small mouse. He is the presiding Deity of the Muladhara Chakra, the psychic centre in the body in which the Kundalini Shakti resides. He is the Lord who removes all obstacles on the path of the spiritual aspirant, and bestows upon him worldly as well as spiritual success. Hence He is called Vigna Vinayaka. The significance of riding on a mouse is the complete conquest over egoism. The holding of the

Ganesh is the first God. Riding on a mouse, one of nature's smallest creatures and having the head of an elephant, the biggest of all animals, denotes that Ganesh is the creator of all creatures. Elephants are very wise animals; this indicates that Lord Ganesh is an embodiment of wisdom. It also denotes the process of evolution--the mouse gradually evolves into an elephant and finally becomes a man. This is why Ganesh has a human body, an elephant's head, and a mouse as His vehicle. This is the symbolic philosophy of His form.

He is the Lord of Ganas or groups, for instance groups of elements, groups of senses, etc. He is the head of the followers of Shiva or the celestial servants of Lord Shiva.

He is very fond of sweet pudding or balls of rice flour with a sweet core. On one of His birthdays He was going around from house to house accepting the offerings of sweet puddings. Having eaten a good number of these, He set out moving on His mouse at night. Suddenly the mouse stumbled--it had seen a snake and became frightened--with the result that Ganesh fell down. His stomach burst open and all the sweet puddings came out. But Ganesh stuffed it back into His stomach and, catching hold of the snake, tied it around His belly.

Seeing all this, the moon in the sky had a hearty laugh. This unseemly behavior of the moon annoyed Him immensely and so he pulled out one of His tusks and hurled it against the moon and cursed that no one should look at the moon on the Ganesh Chaturthi day. If anyone does, he will surely earn a bad name, censure, or ill-repute. However, if by mistake someone does happen to look at the moon on this day, then the only way he can be freed from the curse is by repeating or listening to the story of how Lord Krishna cleared His character regarding the Syamantaka jewel. This story is quoted in the *Srimad Bhagavatam*. Lord Ganesh was pleased to ordain thus. Glory to Lord Ganesh! How kind and merciful He is unto His devotees!

Ganesh and His brother Lord Kartikeya once had a dispute as to who was the elder of the two. The matter was referred to Lord Shiva for final decision. Shiva declared that whoever would go around the whole world and come back first to the starting point would earn the right to be the elder. Kartikeya flew off at once on his vehicle, the peacock, to make a circle around the world. But the wise Ganesh went, in loving worshipfulness, around His divine parents and asked for the prize of His victory.

Lord Shiva said, "Beloved and wise Ganesh! But how can I give you the prize; you did not go around the world?"

Ganesh replied, "No, but I have gone around my parents. My parents represent the entire manifested universe!"

Thus the dispute was settled in favour of Lord Ganesh, who was thereafter acknowledged as the elder of the two brothers. Mother Parvati also gave Him a fruit as a prize for this victory.

In the *Ganapathi Upanishad*, Ganesh is identified with the Supreme Self. The legends that are connected with Lord Ganesh are recorded in the Ganesh Khand of the *Brahma Vivartha Puran*.

On the Ganesh Chaturthi day, meditate on the stories connected with Lord Ganesh early in the morning, during the Brahmamuhurta period. Then, after taking a bath, go to the temple and do the prayers of Lord Ganesh. Offer Him coconut and sweet pudding and pray with faith and devotion.

Don't forget not to look at the moon on that day; remember that it behaved unbecomingly towards the Lord. This really means avoid the company of all those who have no faith in God, and who deride God, your Guru and religion, from this very day.

May the blessings of Shri Ganesh be upon you all! May He remove all the obstacles and bestow on you all material prosperity as well as liberation!




