

THE KRISHNA AVATAR THE DAY OF JANMASHTAMI

Throughout ages, Lord Vishnu, has incarnated in various life forms through different yugas (ages or eons) in situations where Dharma was in danger, because of many evil elements in the world. Hindu mythology describes ten incarnation of Lord Vishnu. These incarnations are termed as the Avatar of Lord Vishnu. Shri Krishna is the eighth Avatar of Lord Vishnu. Krishna in Sanskrit is 'All-Attractive' as well as 'Deep Blue Color' of a saturated cloud (loosely speaking Black) which is the skin color of Shri Krishna (GhanShyam color).

Janmashtami

About five thousand years ago, in Dwaparyug, a unique, transcendental event occurred on this earth and that event was the birth of Shri Krishna in India. His Birthday is popularly, known as 'JANMASHTAMI'. Janma means Birth and Ashtami means 8th day indicating that He was born on the 8th day of the month.

Janmashtami is celebrated in every Vaishnavas home through out the world to mark the birth of Lord Krishna. It is observed on the Ashtami day of the Shravan month according to the Hindu calendar. The temples of Vrindavan witness an extravagant and colorful celebration on this occasion. Raaslila is performed to recreate incidents from the life of Krishna and to commemorate his love for Radha.

Lord Vishnu is invoked in his human incarnation as Krishna on his birth anniversary in the festival of Janmashtami. The idol of the infant Krishna is bathed, decorated and offered prasad at midnight and is placed in a cradle. Devotional songs and dances mark the celebration of this festive occasion all over India and world.

On next day, Nand Mahotsav Day, youths celebrate it by breaking clay pots called 'Dahi-Handi', filled with curd and butter suspended high above the ground, young men and children form human pyramid to reach the pot and break it. This custom follows the Leela of Lord Krishna who used to steal butter in this manner from villagers along with his friends. The reason for this is that Gokul, the place where lord Krishna spent his childhood used to generate a lot of milk and the people used to sell it in Mathura, thus depriving their children from milk and butter which is very essential for young boys and girls.

Appearance of Shri Krishna

In the era of the Svayambhuva Manu, prajapati Sutapa and his wife Prsni were instructed by Lord Brahma to have progeny. They performed severe austerities for twelve thousand years of the demigods to have the Lord as their child. Pleased by their austerities the Lord appeared and granted them this benediction. Since He gave them this benediction three times, in Satyayuga He first appeared as the son of Prsni and Sutapa and was called Prsnigarba. In Tretayuga they were Aditi and Kasyapa Muni and the Lord appeared as Vamanadeva. Finally in the Dvaparyuga, Krishna in His original form appeared as the child of Devaki and Vasudeva.

Krishna appeared specifically on the request of Bhudevi, the presiding deity of the Earth planet. Distressed by the burden of many demons that had appeared as powerful Kshatriyas and were ruling the planet impiously; she assumed the form of a cow and pleaded to Lord Brahma for help. Lord Brahma with all the demigods prayed to Lord Vishnu in Svetadvipa by chanting the Purusa-sukta prayers. At this time the Lord informed Brahma that in order to establish religiosity and destroy evil, He would soon appear as His original Self. In the meantime the various demigods were instructed to take birth in various families in the Yadu dynasty and prepare for the appearance of the Lord.

Historically, Lord Krishna appeared in the Dvaparyuga, on the midnight of the 8th day of the dark half of the month of Shravan. This corresponds to July 19th in the year 3228 BC. (5228 years ago) He exhibited His exploits (Leela) for a little over 125 years and disappeared on February 18th 3102 BC on the new moon night of Phalgun. His departure marks the beginning of the current age of corruption known as Kali.

He was born in Mathura in the prison cell of Kansa and carried to Gokul. The first three years and four months were spent in Gokula, then equal lengths of time in Vrindavan and Nandagram. At the age of eleven He left Vrindavan for Mathura where He lived for eighteen years and four months and finally ninety-six years and eight months in Dwaraka totaling about 126 years of manifest pastimes. At

the time of Mahabharata, when Krishna spoke the Bhagavad-Geeta, He was about ninety years of age.



Shri Krishna Leela

The tenth canto of <u>Shrimad Bhagavat</u> describes the activities and transcendental Leela of Shri Krishna. They are also described in the epic Mahabharata, especially in the Bhishma Parva which also contains the <u>Bhagavad Geeta</u>. The Leela of Krishna appeal to the liberated souls, who are trying to get liberated and also to the gross materialists.

The Katha of Shri Krishna Leela fall into two categories. Words spoken by Krishna, as the <u>Bhagavad Geeta</u>, and words spoken about Krishna, as in the <u>Shrimad Bhagavat</u>. Souls in the liberated stage derive great pleasure in relishing anything

as in the <u>Shrimad Bhagavat</u>. Souls in the liberated stage derive great pleasure in relishing anything and everything related to Krishna. For those that are trying to be liberated, <u>Krishna-katha</u> makes their path of liberation very clear. By studying the Geeta one becomes fully conscious of the position of Sri Krishna; and when one is situated at the lotus feet of the Lord, he understands the narration's of Krishna as described in the Shrimad Bhagavat. All His Leela were purposeful, well, intelligently and diplomatically planned, accurate and yet significant and symbolic.

Shri Krishna is at the top among those who dedicated their lives to a purpose. He assumed the human form and was born on this earth to demonstrate how the life should be led in sorrows, sufferings and happiness. The Shri Krishna was the apostle of perfection, perfect to core. The life of Shri Krishna was so glorious, noble and yet selfless that one can hardly find a parallel of it in the history. Shri Krishna is



described as the outstanding personality of the earth. He possesses all the characteristics of such epoch making personality.

As He is complete in every aspect and possesses all sixteen Kalas or distinctive traits Lord Krishna is regarded as the Sampurna (Complete) Avatar or Purna Purushotam.

Who is Shri Krishna?

Krishna is God, the Supreme Personality of Godhead. This fact is stated and corroborated in the Vedic scriptures and by various authorities. Lord Brahma in Brahma Samhita says, "Krishna who is known as Govind is the Supreme Godhead. He has an eternal

blissful spiritual body. He is the origin of all. He has no other origin and He is the prime cause of all causes" (BS 5.1).

In the Bhagavat Puran Krishna becomes the chief object of devotion. After describing various incarnations of the Lord such as Ram, Balaram, Parashuram, Nrsimha, and Vaman, Srila Sukadeva Goswami states, "All of the above mentioned incarnations are either plenary portions or portions of the plenary portions of the Lord, but Lord Krishna is the original Personality of Godhead" (SB 1.3.28).

Lord Shiva in Geeta Mahatma, states that "only one God - Krishna, the son of Devaki" (Verse 7). In the Padma Puran it is stated, "By scrutinizing reviewing all the revealed scriptures and judging them again and again, it is now concluded that Lord Narayana is the Supreme Absolute Truth, and thus He alone should be worshipped".

Similarly it is said in the Skanda Purana, "In the material world, which is full of darkness and dangers, combined with birth and death and full of different anxieties, the only way to get out of the great entanglement is to accept loving transcendental devotional service to Lord Vasudeva. This is accepted by all classes of philosophers".

Everything emanates from Me" (BG 10.8).

Even though Krishna is completely self sufficient and self satisfied, He descends for the benefit of all the conditioned souls. His most endearing quality is that of "bhakta vatsala". His pure devotees are always trying to please Him, and He is always trying to please His devotees. Just as He lives in the heart of His devotees, His devotees constantly reside in Him.

Krishna is so merciful that He not only helps His devotees, but also those who are envious of Him. Krishna destroys evil by providing them with an opportunity to take up devotion.

On the greatly auspicious day of Krishna-Janamashtami, let us all pray to Sri Krishna for a drop of His causeless mercy, for only that alone is sufficient to take us out from this material word, back home, back to Godhead.


