WHY DO WE JOIN OUR PALMS WHEN WE PRAY? Vijaya Kumaran



Most of us have faith in our own "Ishta Devatha" (Preferred Deity), or "Kuladevatha" (Family Deity) and we express that through "Bhakthi" or devotion in many ways. The word "Bhakthi" means "confidence in, attachment to and high esteem for something (God)". Hindu mythology and legends describe different forms of Bhakti by various spiritual leaders and the results they achieved from those forms.

Here is one of the very simple and easiest ways of expressing devotion or "Bhakthi" towards God. It is called "ANJALI". This one is suitable for all ages, requires no special protocol and can be followed at any time of the day. There are no constraints in this method for anybody to express devotion to their preferred deity.

Swami Vedanta Desikan explains about the grandeur of this approach in his special poems "Anjali Vaibhavam". Swami Desikan was a great devotee, scholar, philosopher, poet and a great Acharya after Sri Ramanuja.

The showing "Mudra" the hands



verses of "Anjali Vaibhavam" explain the process of this type of bakthi. The word "Anjali" means

respect and devotion by folding the hands and joining the both palms as the fingers touch each other. means spiritual stance or pose. Hence, "Anjali Mudra" refers to the expression of devotion by folding and joining the both palms as the fingers touch each other.

This is a very, very simple practice that can be followed by all and towards any deity they trust and adore. Swami Desikan explained the greatness and the fruits one attains out of it clearly. Other saints and spiritual commentators have also referred the merits of this Anjali.

Etymologically, the word 'Anjali' comes from "Am+Jali" which in itself is the abbreviated form of the word "Am+Jalayathi. The first part "Am" denotes Lord Krishna. In Bhagavat Geetha Sri Krishna preaches "'Aksharaanam akarosmi¹..." which means "Among letters I am 'A'".

The second part of the sacred word "Anjali" that is "Jali" which is the abbreviated form the word "Jalayathi" in Sanskrit, meaning "liquefy" or "melt". That means "Melts the heart of God" and in other words makes him shower his grace and blessings on one who shows this sign, with implicit trust and focused mind. Swami Desikan explains that this uncomparable 'mudra' destroys all the sins, and brings down gods grace in natural flow forever. Never will it reduce its effects nor will it fail for any reason, Swami elaborates through his words "Na jaadhu heeyathe".

Many poems and books speak about the grandeur of this Anjali Mudra. Sri Parasara Battar - a famous Vaishnav Parampara scholar in his book "Sri Guna Rathna Kosam" and Koorathazhvan, another poet in his book "Sri Vaikuntasthava" portray the magnificence of "Anjali" mudra that showers all benefits and shows the route to reach the Lord.



The dark fortnight of Ashwin Month is known as Mahalaya Paksha or the fortnight especially sacred for offering oblations to the departed ancestors. The last day of this period, the new moon day (Amavasya), is considered as the most important day in the year for performing obsequies and rites (or in simple terms offerings to our dearly departed ancestors). This year it falls on the 28th September 2008.

In the Garuda Purana Preta khanda II 10.50-55 Lord Visnu says to Sri Garudaji "On the day of Amavasya (new moon day), the airy manes (the ancestors) stand at the door of their descendents in order to receive their food. They remain there till sunset. When they do not receive their food they fall in despair and out of suffering heave long sighs and go back cursing the descendents. Therefore, one should carefully perform shraddha (offer food) to your ancestors on the new moon day (Amavasya).

The final day of Pitrus Paksha is the Mahalaya Amavasya (the dark night before new moon)- September 28th in 2008. This takes place when the Sun and Moon conjunct in Virgo. All the ancestors are prayed to on this day. The belief is that they all come down to earth from their abode to join the world of living for a day.

If you want to remember your departed loved ones, this is a good time to do so. If you do not know the Tithi of their death, then you could do it on the Amavasya day. Feed the poor, give donation and celebrate their life with a feast in their memory- usually a vegetarian and Sattvic food. honor their memory and remember them with fondness.

The Shraddh performed during Pitru Paksha are not funeral ceremonies. They are Yagyas for the Pitru, worship of the ancestors as deities. They are different from the worship of the God. Shraddh is mainly performed for three generations of Pitrus, namely the father, the grandfather, and the great grandfather. When performed for all the ancestors performer's family benefit from it.







It is believed that when God decides to give punishment to the sinners, He sends it in the form of arrows. If the person performs this Anjali mudra then the arrows lose their powers and return back to the sender himself. The devotion expressed through that mudra has got that much significance and power.

Such explanations are seen in Mahabharata as well. In Mahabharata, when Draupathi was disrobed and dishonoured at the Kauravas court she sought refuge in Lord Krishna by joining her hands and doing Anjali, crying "Govinda! Govinda". In an instant, Lord Krishna saves her from humiliation by making her saree infinitely long.

At the beginning of the Mahabharatha war at Kurukshetram after the preachings of Bhagavat Geetha, Yuthisthira went to 'pithamahar Bhishma' to get his blessings. While he was walking towards Bhishma he demonstrates utmost devotion by doing this Anjali mudra –folding his hands and joining palms. Seeing this, Bhishma was very pleased and said "Oh my child your Anjali at this circumstance melts my heart. If you hadn't come here with this humility, I would have cursed you towards defeat and death. Now this clearly shows that you are uncomparable, I bless you to attain all successes in this war" said Bhishma". This clearly describes the power of Anjali.

When Ashwathama shoots the "Narayana Asthram" the most powerful weapon towards the Pandava army it was expected that the total army would be destroyed and burnt to ashes. At that moment all the warriors in the Pandava army start praying performing "Anjali" towards God. The Narayana Asthram then loses its power and returns back to Ashwathama without doing any harm to the Pandava army.

These examples gauge the merits of Anjali. The chief of Dravida Saints, Nammazhvar also speaks about the grace and the power of expressing devotion through Anjali in his verses "Thiruvai Mozhi". This is considered to be the most important work in the compilation of the four thousand verses-'Naalayira Divya Prabhandham" ². He says even at one's deathbed it is advisable to do Anjali. That takes one to the lotus feet of the Lord.

Thus, there are several references that explain the greatness and fruits of this powerful but simple mudra. This mudra delivers its message without any efforts, any money or any other difficult austerities. The devotion and bhakthi expressed through this mudra showers all blessing from the almighty. Without any differences or restrictions the same Anjali mudra pleases all gods and goddesses whether it is Narayana, Krishna, Rama, Durga, Lakshmi Saraswathi, Muruga or all the Navagrahas or in other words everyone's "Ishta Devatha" and brings all good things to the devotee. With sincere devotion and focused mind any one can express their Bhakthi in this simple way. Thus from these examples we can conclude that it is a very simple method that guarantees God's blessings and His presence in our lives all the time.
