Makarsankranti, Uttaryan, pongal, Lohri

Makar Sankranti is celebrated on 14 January. Sankranti means to go from one place to another place or to change direction. It also means one meets another. The time when the sun changes direction from one constellation of the zodiac to another is known as Sankranti.



Transition of the Sun from Sagittarius to Capricorn (Makar) during the winter solstice in the northern hemisphere (Uttarayana) is known as Makar Sankranti. There are 12 signs of the zodiac therefore; there are 12 Sankrantis as well. They are given names according to the position of the sun in relation to the signs of the zodiac. Each of the 12 Sankrantis has its relevant importance but two of these are most prominent. These two are **Mesh (Aries)** Sankranti and **Makar (Capricorn)** Sankranti.

The Makar Sankranti is of great importance. It is also called Uttarayana: Uttar means North and Aayana means Journey or Transition. (It seems like the sun begins its journey northward but as we know that it's the earth coming closer and facing the northern hemisphere to the sun). The days are gradually getting longer and becoming warmer in the northern hemisphere, spring arrives and all festivities start.

Makar Sankranti festival is celebrated differently in the different parts of India. People throng to the holy rivers in large numbers for the sacred dip. The Kumbh Mela is held on this auspicious day once every 12 years at Prayag in Allahabad.

In Tamilnadu this festival is called the **Pongal**, from whom it ushers in the New Year. The day begins with Surya Pongal or sun worship. The newly harvested corn is then cooked for the first time. In fact, the sun itself stands for all the ideals of the Pongal festival "Share what you have with all" – this is the clarion call of the Pongal festival.

In Gujarat and other western states it is called both Makar Sankranti as well as Uttarayana. It is observed by flying thousands of colorful paper kites as if the winter sky has bursted into colorful oblations to the Sun god. The festivities conclude with a winter feast.

In Maharashtra, people dress in new clothes and distribute sesame seeds sweets, it is significant to note that Til seeds (sesame seeds) and jaggery are used everywhere. Obviously, to combat the chilly winter, being soft, exchanging Til seeds or products made from Til means an exchange of love and tender feelings. In Punjab it is celebrated as Lohri or Maghi as it falls in the month of Magh in Hindu calendar. It is celebrated with music and dancing around the camp fire with grand feast and festivities. Joyous festivities mark the celebration in every home. Servants, farmers and the poor are fed and clothed, and given presents of money. On the next day, the cow, which is regarded as the symbol of the Holy Mother, is worshipped. Birds and animals are also fed.

In this manner the devotee's heart gradually expands during the course of the celebrations. Love extends from the household to servants, the poor, the cow and all other living creatures.

During this holy festival we learn to feel our oneness with all creation; we learn to be unselfish and to tread the path of love, purity and forgiveness. We learn that our real wealth is the goodwill and friendship of those around us, the land on which our food grows, and the animals that help to make our work lighter.

The sun stands for knowledge, spiritual light and wisdom. Makara Sankranti signifies that we should turn away from the darkness of delusion in which we live, and begin to joyously let the light within us shine brighter and brighter. We should gradually begin to grow in purity, wisdom, and knowledge, even as the sun does from this day.

Its message is that of light, unity, equality and true selflessness. These are the ideals of Karma Yoga. Hence, the sun is the greatest Karma Yogi. Does it ask any reward for all that it gives to us? If it stops shedding its light, we are doomed to death. If we learn this one lesson from the sun, our lives will shine with divine luster like that of the sun.



Vasant Panchami

The 5th day of the bright fortnight of the lunar month of *Maagha* is the day of Vasant Panchami. Hindus all over the world celebrate this festival with great enthusiasm. This Panchami is also known as Saraswati Day. It is believed that this auspicious day is the day when Goddess Saraswati appeared. On this day Goddess Saraswati is worshipped as the Goddess of Learning, the deity of Gayatri, the fountain of fine arts and science, and the symbol of supreme vedantic knowledge.

Vasant Panchami is a festival full of religious, seasonal and social significance and is celebrated with verve and new sense of optimism. (You read 'The Spiritual Significance of Vasant panchami' in March 2008 issue of Aradhana.) The other significant aspect of this day is that children are taught reading and writing their first words on this day - as it is considered an auspicious day to begin a child's education. Educational institutions organize special prayers for Saraswati on this day. Saintly people and people inclined towards spiritual progress attach great importance to the worship of goddess Saraswati. As a practice, people of principle worship goddess Saraswati for spiritual enlightenment. In their opinion, there can be no comparison be-

tween the king and the learned or the spiritually advanced. They believe that the king is honoured within his kingdom, whereas the learned are respected or worshipped throughout the world. The god of love (*Kaamadeva*) is also worshipped on this day.

The first faint signals of the forthcoming festival of Holi manifest at Vasant Panchami. Seasons undergo change. The coming of springtime is heralded. Trees are displaying new shoots. New life is evident in the woods and fields. Nature decorates Mango trees with new blossoms. Wheat and other crops enliven with evidence of new life.
