Twenty Fifth Annual Thyagaraja/Purandaradasa Festival April 17, 2010 (Saturday)

This year marks the twenty fifth year of our annual Thyagaraja/Purandaradasa Festival that we have traditionally celebrated in the month of March/April at our temple. A small but devout gathering of classical music lovers has enthusiastically participated and volunteered over the years to celebrate the festival. Here is a brief description of the two great saints of our tradition whose memories we celebrate during the festival.

Great men appear from time to time as if sent by God for the purpose of elevating humanity. Saint Thyagaraja was one such extraordinary personality born to teach humanity the path of salvation through Music and Ramabakthi. His contribution to the cultural growth of India is unique. He was a practical philosopher and dedicated his entire life to the practice of NADOPASANA. He had composed several Kritis in various ragas. His songs are filled with an intimate devotion to Rama, revealing his deep understanding of the tenets of the Vedas and Upanishads.

Purandara Dasa is famous among the Haridasas of Karnataka; foremost among the talented carnatic composers. He earned a lot of wealth [“Navakoti Narayana (an abundantly rich man)”, was one of his titles!]. But he gave it all away readily to become an ardent devotee of Lord Narayana. He practiced the principle contained in the popular saying "we must swim across suffering and win victory over it". He earned the well-deserved praise-'Among the devotees of Hari, Purandara Dasa is the greatest'(from his preceptor Sri Vyaasa Teertha). Purandara Dasa is a testimony to the aphorism “*kSHipram bhavati dharmaatma* (readily becomes righteous)” found in the Bhagavad-Gita (9:31a).A day-long celebration of these great composers of carnatic music will be held at the Temple.

Balvihar Group

(Butler-Warren counties, near Cincinnati, OH)

Senior students of this group studied & memorized the verses of 12th Chapter of Bhagvat Gita, chanted by rote, interpreted them and each of them wrote about five verses, respectively.

Arjuna asks, "**Who is the better devotee?** The devotee who focuses on Bhagavan or the devotee who focuses on an abstract form?" Bhagavan says, "Both devotees are equal, because the one who is focusing on an abstract form will sooner or later reach me. However, the devotee who focuses on the abstract form has more obstacles in being devoted."

My interpretation: "It doesn't matter what type of praying you do as long as you completely concentrate on whoever or whatever you are praying on. For example, if I had a tennis lesson, I would completely focus on what the instructor was saying." I think I could use this concept on everything I do. For example if I have a test I would just study and completely focus on studying. I would give my complete attention to anything I do and by following that rule, I will be thorough in everything.

..

The verses mean that you should **do your work in the name of God and give up the fruits of the labor** and just try to focus on Him and be totally devoted to Him.

I think that God just wants you to be totally focused on Him and that you should have faith in Him because when you put in the effort, the results will take care of themselves and the output will always be proportionate to the input. Also, you should do work for the sake of wanting to do a good job, not because you'll get something in return.

I think we could use this in daily life by studying for a test, not because we want an A, but rather because we want to learn and retain knowledge. Also, we shouldn't put in extra effort on the job just because we want a raise, but rather for the joy of doing a good job and the satisfaction of finishing it when you're done. What is challenging, however, is that we live in a world where the only thing that matters is the outcome. but I think we have the ability to change that if we are willing to.

...

The Gita says to give up all the fruits of actions. To be devoted to God, first practice the disciplines. Even better than that is meditation and the best is to **abandon fruits of the actions**. Also it says one should be a balanced person.

I agree to give up the fruits of action. I should try to focus on getting the goal, not what happens after that. To be a balanced person would be very hard because one has to keep one's emotions together.

If your dad says he will give you an I-pod when you get over 98% on your math test, then I would study very hard and get 100%. One should be proud of oneself, not be happy that one would get an I-pod. To be a balanced person for me would be very hard. I would have to keep my emotions to myself and not show or express any bad feelings.

Krishna tells Arjuna **what kind of devotee is most dear to Him**. Krishna explains that his ideal devotee would be *balanced* in whatever he/she does. He explains that the devotee should never get too concerned with anything or become too attached. He shows that his devotee will be kind to and caring towards everyone and keep an open mind.

To me this means that the devotee is kind, caring and easy-going with one and all. He never gets arrogant or depressed. He always stays calm and never gets too attached to whatever he is doing. He does his duty to the best of his ability without worrying about the fruits of his actions. He never goes to extremes over anything and is always even and accepts anything that comes his way with calmness and understanding.

I can use the verses in the twelfth chapter as guidelines in daily life as well as in school. I need to be kind to everyone in my life. This all sounds very good but carrying it out will be another challenge on its own. I understand that being a balanced person will be rather difficult for me because I enjoy being mean, rude, sarcastic and carefree. I will however try to be a more balanced person through constant effort.

1. Laxmi Srivastava made a motion to form a committee to revise the temple employee hand book. The proposal seconded by Anisha Singh. 2. Laxmi Srivastava made a motion to form an Editorial Board for Aradhana and Visitors Booklet. The proposal seconded by Raneshwar Gupta. EC approved Dr. Rama Rao Pappu, Dr. Koti Sreekrishna, Geeta Mehan (Editor), Dr. Meena Mehta and Dr. Laxmi S. Srivastava (Temple Manager). Editorial Board will provide their recommendations and action plan to EC.
3. Meena Mehta proposed Patron Day Committee to organize this yearly event. Laxmi Srivastava seconded the motion in favor. EC approved the committee consisting of President, Fundraising Chair, Cultural Chair, Temple Manager, Meena Mehta and Jitu Patel.

Minutes:

1. Garbhagraha (Kaptagraha) – This is a special project. The builder engaged to build the Garbhagraha is from Bangalore. He recently visited Cincinnati. Architect Bill Fiedler has seen the model and the final plans are being drawn up now. The final plan will be presented to the executive council as well as to the general body. This project is expected to be completed this calendar year.
2. Placement of speakers inside temple – Placement of the speakers will not be changed at present. These may be moved to an inconspicuous location or hidden from public view at a later date.
3. Yagya Shala
 - a. This project will be fully funded by Dr. Jagdish Kulkarni. Therefore, it will not need any additional funds.
 - b. Groundbreaking ceremony of Yagya Shala will be held on 18th Feb, 2010. To be announced in Aradhana.
4. Retirement Community Project – This project is going through the site planning process Temple needs \$200,000 to finish road from second entrance from Barg Salt Run Rd.

The basic packet will be for \$21 and the larger packet with Havan samagri will be available for \$31. Separate boxes for the 3 priests will be provided to enable them to sell the samagri.
22. A blower near the table should be placed where Pooja thalis are sold to provide heat to volunteers
23. Downstairs Hall – A Professional kitchen will be completed this year. Project has acquired final zoning permit and partial building permit. Jitu Patel is working on this project. We need generous donation to finish this project.

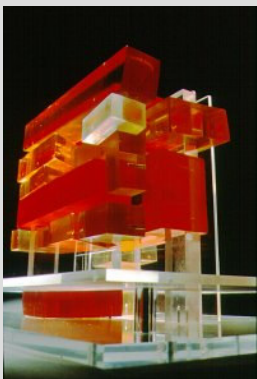



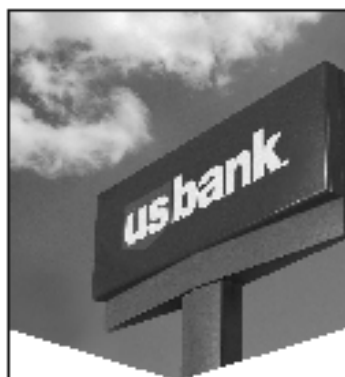
