DHARMA & SVADHARMA in BHAGAVAD-GITA: by Koti Sreekrishna

Like most Sanskrit words, the word dharma too has different meanings in different contexts. It is important that the meaning pertaining to a given context is understood properly. Otherwise dharma itself will become adharma! Let us examine the related verses in the Bhagavad-Gita.

Bg 2:31

Even from the point of view of your own duty as a warrior you should not hesitate to fight. There is nothing superior for a warrior than a war fought for preserving dharma.

Here, 'dharma' refers to righteousness. What the Kauravas did was both unlawful and immoral;

the war was being fought for self-defense as well as for the larger good.

BG2:33

Now if you don't fight in this battle sanctioned by dharma, you will be making the mistake of ignoring your own duty and reputation.

In this context, dharma is duty.

BG3:35a

Following one's own dharma, even if it is less glamorous is better than trying to excel in another one's dharma. Here, 'one's own dharma' refers to 'work in tune with one's inherent nature'. One should not try to imitate others, but be natural, free from deceit, and true to oneself. By staying close to what we are intrinsically good at, we attain personal success and also become valuable to society. See also 18:45-48.

BG3:35b

It is better to die upholding one's dharma; following the dharma of others is worse than death. Krishna indicates that it is better for Arjuna, the warrior, to die in this war, rather than follow a path unsuited to his nature, which will end up being dangerous for him.

BG4:7

Whenever there is a decline of dharma and a rise of adharma, I manifest myself in this world.

Dharma is that which sustains everything; it is more than mere righteousness. Adharma is the opposite of dharma; it is more than mere unrighteousness. One should be moral not simply because it is accepted as a good thing by society. A deeper understanding reveals that true morality is something that is in line with nature and natural laws. When one goes against natural laws, one is affected.

By definition, dharma protects one who protects it (dharmo rakSHati rakSHitah). In fact, this could have been a better motto than "satyameva jayate" (Truth alone triumphs)! Because, what good is "Satya" without "Dharma"?

Bg4:8

To protect the good, to destroy evil, and to firmly establish dharma, I manifest myself time and again.

Here, 'good' not only refers to sages but also to ordinary helpless folk, who are exploited by the wicked. History has shown that during a great crisis, someone rises to the occasion, assumes leadership, and brings about change. Krishna presents the concept of incarnation (avatara)

without limitations of space or time. That is why BG, which is primarily an eternal scriptures (for all ages) is not STUCK on just Das Avatars like many contextual scriptures which fade right in front of our eyes, provided, we care to open it!

BG 7:11

In those who are strong, I am pure strength, devoid of lust and passion. Yet, in all beings, I am the desire that does not violate dharma.

Here dharma refers to a moral law or principle.

BG 9: 1 & 2

Arjuna, because you are interested in my words, I shall reveal to you the best of secrets, which is practical knowledge guided by wisdom.

You will be free from sorrow if you know this. This is the best of secrets*, the highest knowledge. It is the supreme purifier. It aligns with dharma and it is imperishable. It is easy to practice and one can experience it directly.

* In fact, the best of secrets is revealed in the ultimate verses of this chapter (BG 9:30-32). Interestingly, this has remained pretty much a secret to many of our gate keepers!

BG 9: 30-32

Even if a man steeped in evil takes on to my worship with undivided devotion, he must be considered as noble because he has taken the right decision. Readily, he becomes righteous and attains everlasting peace. Arjuna, know this: no devotee of mine is ever lost. Whoever takes refuge in me –even men of sinful birth, women, traders, or laborers –will attain the supreme goal. Societies typically (especially ours) look down upon certain sections of people. Krishna clarifies that whoever submits to the supreme attains liberation, irrespective of their birth, gender, or occupation. Isn't this funny that our gate keepers kept this as a secret to themselves and the society? Even to this date, if a Missionary says we take you all, as and where you are, our Brihaspathis have nothing much to say objectively and point them to mile long bhaashHyams (treatises)! Ashta Prakari Puja



In Ashta Prakari puja following eight items are needed to perform puja of Shri Mahvir ji (Tirthankar). Symbolically each item represents a specific religious virtue and one should reflect on it while performing puja.

1. Jala Puja: (Water) 2. Chandan Puja: (Sandal-wood) 3. Pushpa Puja: (Flower) 4. Dhoop Puja (Incense)
5. Dipak Puja (Candle) 6. Akshat Puja (Rice) 7. Naivedya Puja (Sweet food) 8. Fal Puja: (Fruit)

1. Jala Puja: (Water)

Water symbolizes the ocean. Every living being continuously travels through life's ocean of birth, death, and misery. This puja reminds that one should live his life with honesty, truthfulness, love, and compassion towards all living beings. This way one will be able to cross life's ocean and attain liberation (Moksha). This is known as samyak-darshana, samyak-jnana, and samyak-charitra in the Jain religion.

2. Chandan Puja: (Sandal-wood)

Chandan symbolizes knowledge (jnana). By doing this puja, one should thrive for right knowledge. Jainism believes that the path of knowledge is the main path to attain Moksha or liberation. Bhakti or devotion helps in the early stages of one's effort for liberation.

3. Pushpa Puja: (Flower)

the flower symbolizes conduct. Our conduct should be like a flower, which provides fragrance and beauty to all living beings without discrimination. We should live our life like flowers full of love and compassion towards all living beings.

4. Dhoop Puja: (Incense)

Dhoop symbolizes monkhood life. While burning itself, incense provides fragrance to others. Similarly, true monks and nuns spend their entire life selflessly for the benefit of all living beings. This puja reminds that one should thrive for a ascetic life.

5. Dipak Puja: (Candle)

The flame of dipak represents a pure consciousness, i.e. A soul without any bondage of a karma or a liberated soul. In Jainism, such a soul is called a Siddha or God. The ultimate goal of every living being is to become liberated. By doing this puja one should thrive to follow five great vows; non-violence, truthfulness, non-stealing, chastity, and non-possession. Ultimately these vows will lead to liberation.

6. Akshat Puja: (Rice)

Rice is a kind of grain which is nonfertile. One cannot grow rice plants by seeding rice. Symbolically, it means that rice is the last birth. By doing this puja one should thrive to put all the efforts in life in such a way that this life becomes one's last life, and after the end of this life one will not be reborn again.

7. Naivedya Puja: (Sweet food)

Naivedya symbolizes tasty food. By doing this puja, one should thrive to reduce or eliminate attachment to tasty food. Healthy food is essential for survival, however one should not live for tasty food. Ultimate aim in one's life is to attain a life where no food is essential for survival. That is the life of a liberated soul who lives in Moksha for ever in ultimate blissful state.

8. Fal Puja: (Fruit)

Fruit is a symbol of Moksha or liberation. If we live our life without any attachment to worldly affairs, continue to perform our duty without any expectation and reward, be a witness to all the incidents that occur surrounding us, truly follow monk-hood life, and have a love and compassion to all living beings, we will attain the fruit of liberation. This is the last puja symbolizing the ultimate achievement of our life.

Gajapati Maharaja Dibyasinghdeo Deb

Since the Suryavanshi kings (15th-16th century), Odisha is called Bhagawat desh and Puri is called Purusottama Kshetra or in short form Purastam. Orissa is therefore called the land of Purusottama or Jagannath Desh. King Kapileswara's Inscriptions (1893) in the temple of Lord Jagannath show that the king treated the deity as the Supreme Lord of Odisha and himself as his representative. He used to bring to the notice of the Lord important facts relating to the administration of the kingdom. Even for granting charities or inflicting punishment the king used to seek permission of the Lord.. The Lord used to give in every case his verdict in dreams to the kings who sought for his judgement. This belief fortified the king's position as the Lord's Representative and the whole administration was running under the orders of Lord Jagannath. The Suryavanshi King Purushottama Deva also acted as the representative of the Lord. When he made an expedition to conquer Kanchi, Lord Jagannath and Lord Balabhadra on black and white horses went ahead of the army to participate in the war. King Purushottama Deva could easily conquer Kanchi and brought the princess Padmavati and the presiding deity of Kanchipuram, Sri Ganesh. This event is known as 'Kanchi Vijaya' of king Purushottam Deva.

When the British occupied Orissa in 1803, the British Army was instructed by Lord Wellesely that on the occupation of Puri, all possible precaution should be taken to preserve the religious beliefs and shrine without interfering in the activities of the priests. The control over the temple was transferred to Raja of Puri, Sri Birakishora Deva in 1863 and the government thereafter ceased to have any connection with the management of the temple. According to Act of 1840, the duties of the Superintendent of the Temple was vested with the Raja of Puri. This title enabled the king to be the Sevaka Raja of the Jagannath temple. Since then the Raja of Puri is the Thakura Raja and he is respected both by law and custom to be the Chief Sevaka of the Lord. After independence, the temple was managed by the Raja of Puri and now it is managed by an Administrator under Sri Jagannath Temple Act, 1952 but honour for the Raja of Puri as the Chief Sevaka is retained even now.

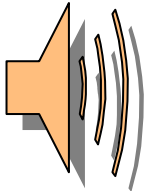

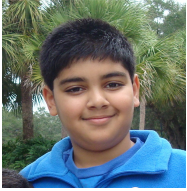
EC Meeting Minutes– 22nd February, 2010

Minutes:

1. Indian artist Shilpa Gupta has been invited by the Contemporary Art Center of Cincinnati. Children from Balvihar class will be taken to the art center to see the work of Shilpa Gupta.
2. The lock on the suggestion box will be broken as the key to the lock cannot be found. It will be opened in the presence of Krutarth and Laxmi ji.
3. Status of different committees: Laxmi ji will discuss the status of various subcommittees in next meeting as some of these subcommittees are not under the control of the executive council.
4. Krutarth will look into conflict of interest policy as well as board member responsibilities. He stated that the executive council should have greater involvement in major functions.
5. The executive council decided that the rates for advertisement in Aradhana for non-profit organizations involved in social work may be adjusted on a case-by-case basis.
6. The temple anniversary will be celebrated on May 21st to May 23rd. The executive council agreed to consider the use of the Swami fund to pay for domestic travel to Cincinnati by the ex-King of Puri and his immediate family to grace the occasion.
7. The Maha Shivratri function was a success. Over 700 devotees attended the function and over \$6,000 were collected in this event.
8. For the upcoming Holi function, 500 people are expected. Drinks have been donated for the function. Samosas will be procured at a discounted price. The cultural function committee is trying to get sponsorship for Pizza. For the Holi function, over 158 participants have enrolled. An amateur band is also coming to the temple to play music.
9. The executive council has decided that if a council member is expected to be absent, then an alternate will be designated in advance for the absentee council member. Bala (Vice-president) will serve as alternate for Deepak Dixit (Secretary). Amar Sharma will serve as the alternate for Prasad Megada.
10. The executive council also decided that the monthly meeting will be held on set dates even if certain council members are expected to be absent by using the alternates.
11. The executive council agreed to take annual inventories of the ornaments, sarees etc. Pictures of the ornaments and other valuables will be taken and verified periodically.
12. The executive committee will deliberate further on possible sale of gold (not used for deity shringar/ornaments) donated to the temple for use in certain projects. This issue will also be placed for consideration in front of the general body.
13. Fund raising and membership
 - Priority needs to be given to increase membership of HSGC.
 - A separate meeting will be called to discuss the membership drive.
 - Information was shared about the Meijer card that it works quite differently from the Kroger card.

BG 14:26 & 27

One who sincerely worships me through the path of devotion, crossing the barriers of guna is ready to attain brahman. For I am the basis of brahman – the immortal, the imperishable, the absolute bliss, and the eternal dharma. The 'eternal dharma' refers to the natural law that governs universal welfare.

BG 16:8

They (the demonic) proclaim: "The universe has no basis and no abiding truth. There is no greater force governing it. Life is merely a product of mutual union, driven by lust!" Here, 'basis' refers to dharma, that which supports and sustains everything.

BG 18:34

The tenacity with which one vehemently hangs on to the pursuits of dharma, artha, and kama, out of selfish desire for the Fruits of action, that Resolve is of the nature of rajas. Dharma, artha, and kama refer to the moral, material, and sensory fulfillments.

Such people claim that the universe has no meaningful order; they also fail to see a larger purpose for any activity. (Rajasik people will compete even in humility; they will say "I am more humble than you"!)

BG 18:47

Try to excel in your own dharma, even if it is less glamorous. It is better than following others dharma. You will not experience any guilt if you follow your inherent nature. See also 3:35 Here, 'dharma' is a reference to the essence of one's personality including his attitude, talent, and nurturing environment.

BG 18:66

Giving up all forms of dharma take refuge in me alone. I will liberate you from all sins, do not grieve! Here, dharma is used in the widest sense of the word –law, virtue, support, religion, duty, path, etc. Krishna gives a simple path to liberation: the path of surrender to the Supreme. This path is readily accessible to everyone*** without the need for an organized religion or a mediator; it is free from rules and distinctions.

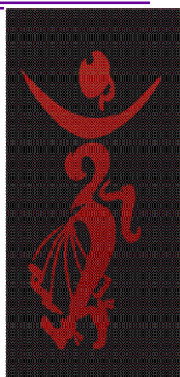
