### BHAGAVAD-GITA SAAR (The Essence of Song Divine) by Koti Sreekrishna

Bhagavad-Gita is the most comprehensive summary of Sanatana Dharma (Hinduism). It is among the most popular Hindu scriptures. It is the longest Philosophical song (700 verses) in the world literature. This is the book many Hindus swear on in the court of law. Bhagavad-Gita is a dialogue between Lord Krishna and prince Arjuna at the outset of Mahabharata war. A royal family feud which resulted in a wholesale war that lasted for 18 days (Nov 22- Dec 9; 3067 BCE). This war is recorded to have taken place in Kurukshetra (a place in the state of Haryana, near India's capital New Delhi) about 5000 years ago. Krishna says to Arjuna that He had given the same message in the great past to the patriarchs of Solar Dynasty. The message was passed on in succession for many generations through the lineage of philosopher kings such as Manu and Ikshvaku (the ancestors of Sri Rama). However, with time, the essence was lost, and "I have appeared in the human form to revive it"! Yes, such revival happens in every generation, which makes Hinduism a dynamic and vibrant religion- old and new at the same time!

Here is the essence of the Bhagavad-Gita:

- \*God is omnipotent, omnipresent, the source, and the destination.
- \* God can be readily seen and/or experienced as the best of best in anything or anyone.
- \*True knowledge is to know God.
- \*Death is only to the body. Soul takes on new forms until it is liberated (united with God).
- \*Once we surrender to God, we are free from cycles of birth and death.
- \*The good eventually wins over evil.
- \* No good act goes to waste; only haste makes a wasted life!
- \* You are responsible for your actions and your destination. You reap as you sow.
- \* Who ever turn to God is readily saved. There is no status or gender priority with God.
- \*God reincarnates, when needed to establish dharma (righteousness).
- \*The form of God we worship, God fixes our faith in that very form.
- \*All pray to the same one God. True believers of God never fail.
- \*Action is inevitable. No one can keep quiet. Do the work that suits you the best (follow your bliss).

Five factors govern the outcome all actions (good or bad): Timing of action, individual, tools at one's disposal, how the tools are used, and the unknown (fate, luck/chance, providence, past Karma). Thus, do the best you can with what you have and where you are. After all, that is the best any one can do!
- \* Saintly (calm, collective, and active), showy (hyper active, greedy, passionate) and lazy (dull, lethargic) are human nature. Tend towards being more saintly in your thoughts, words, and deeds.
- \* Rise above the differences of pain and pleasure, good and bad, loss and gain, love and hate, etc.
- \*Dedicate all your actions to God.
- \*Share your fortunes with others; otherwise you are nothing but a thief.
- \* Accept all blessings (food, fortune, friends and whatever life brings) with gratitude and humility.
- \*Always support what is right.
- \*Follow moderation. Maintain a good balance of work, leisure, food and pleasure.

# APPEAL REGARDING ROAD REPAIR

Dear Devotees.

As you are already aware, due to the severe weather we had this past winter, both sides of the Temple road conditions have deteriorated & need immediate repair and attention. This project requires patching up the holes and thick blacktop from the main gate all the way to the back of the Temple where the dumpster is on both sides of the road. We want to start this repair project as soon as possible. As you know it will require around \$50,000. We want all members and devotees to share the cost. When the supreme being begins to manifest its cosmic energy, it is variously known as Sakti. Devi or Divine Mother, who assumes many forms according to the tasks to be preformed by her. She is also known as Durga, Lakshmi or Sarawati in her destructive, protective, and knowledge giving roles respectively. All three apects of the Divine Mother are worshipped during Devi Navaratri puja, the nine nights.

Navratri festival is observed twice a year, once in the month of Chaitra and then in Aswayuja. It lasts for nine days in honour of the nine manifestations of Durga. During Navaratri (the word literally means "nine nights") devotees of Durga observe a fast. Brahmins are fed and prayers are offered for the protection of health and property.

### Significance

Durga, also known as Kali, or the destructive aspect of the divine mother is worshipped during the first three nights .. On the succeeding three knights, her protective aspect of Lakshmi, also the giver of spiritual wealth is worshipped. On the last three nights, her knowledge and wisdom aspect or Saraswati are worshipped. The significance of this order is that first Durga destroys all the evil propensities lurking in the minds of her devotees; then Lakshmi implants divine qualities in the devotees' minds and finally Saraswati bestows true knowledge to her devotees. The tenth day known as Vijaya Dasami, commemorates the victory of knowledge over ignorance of goodness over evil. For all around success in life, believers seek the blessings of all three aspects of the divine femininity.

The Navratri commences on the first day (pratipada) of the bright fortnight of the lunar month of Ashwin. The festival is celebrated for nine nights once every year during the beginning of October, although as the dates of the festival are determined according to the lunar calendar, Navaratri is celebrated in different ways throughout India. In North India, all three Navratris are celebrated with much fervor by fasting on all nine days and worshipping the Mother Goddess in her different forms. The Chaitra Navratri culmintes in Ram Navami and the Sharad Navratri culminates in Durga Puja and Dussehra. The Dussehra of Kulu in Himachal Pradesh is particularly famous in the North.

The last four days of Sharad Navratri take on a particularly dramatic form in the state of West Bengal in East India where they are celebrated as Durga Puja. This is the biggest festival of the year in this state. Exquisitely crafted and decorated life-size clay idols of the Goddess Durga depicting her slaying the demon Mahisasura are set up in temples and other places. These idols are then worshipped for five days and immersed in the river on the fifth day.

In Western India, particularly in the state of Gujarat, Navratri is celebrated with the famous Garba and Dandiya-Raas dance. Since the past few years, the Government Of Gujarat has been organising the "Navratri Festival Celebrations" on a regular basis for the nine days of Navratri Festival, in Gujarat. People from all over Gujarat and even abroad come to participate in the nine days celebrations. It is also popular throughout India and among Indian communities around the world including UK and USA.

In South India, people set up steps and place idols on them. This is known as golu. Photos of typical Golu displayed in Tamil Nadu style at a home in Nerul, Navi Mumbai, Maharashtra, India is shown by the side. In South India, Saraswati pooja is performed on the 9th day. Eight day is traditionally Durgashtami which is big in Bengal. The 10th day is Ayudha Pooja when everyone gives their tools of the trade—pens, machinery, books, automobiles, school work, etc. a rest and ritually worships them. They start a fresh from the next day, the 10th day which is considered as 'Vijaya Dasami'. On this tenth day of Navratri in October - the holiday of Dussehra, an effigy of Ravana is burnt to celebrate the victory of good (Rama) over evil.

During Navratri, some devotees of Durga observe a fast and prayers are offered for the protection of health and prosperity. A period of introspection and purification, Navratri is traditionally an auspicious and religious time for starting new ventures.

### Significance of Tree worship

From the ancient times, trees have been the focus of religious life for many peoples, around the world. As the largest plant on earth, the tree has been a major source of stimulation to the mythic imagination. Trees have been invested in all cultures with a dignity unique to their own nature,

In Hinduism, it is believed that the God lives in trees (Banyan,Peepal,Bliva etc.) and all married women on full moon day of the month of Jyeshtha (June) fast and worship Vat tree known as Vat Savitri Vrat. They also tie red thread around it and offer flowers and sweets to the tree. All prayers are offered for growth and strength of their family. It symbolizes a long life and also represents the divine creator, Brahma. It is invariably planted in front of temples. 
