SIGNIFICANCE OF FALL (Sharad) - (Koti Sreekrishna)

The trees with fresh leaves start in spring and assimilate all through the summer and look bountiful. When Fall arrives, they let go of this bounty in such a majestic and graceful manner, with all the wonderful color changes covering almost every hue one can imagine.

There is an important message for us here: We are born; just like those tender Spring leaves. We should carefully assimilate all the goodies to the fullest of OUR abilities, just like those trees that assimilate and become fruitful (making hay while the Sun shines). When the time comes, the trees let go off that assimilated treasure gracefully (not like the way most of us grudgingly send our taxes to IRS in April) and drop off the very same leaves that nourished the fruits, making ground for the next batch.

We didn't create this world - we only use this world to earn whatever (power/strength, knowledge, wealth) and we should let that go for the good of the world. This is our obligation to this wonderful world and to our Maker that we take for granted!

Hinduism attaches a special significance for the Fall season. The Vedic mantras are full of reverence and reference to Fall (Sharad).

Everyday, gazing at the bright Sun, a Vedic seeker utters:

Let me live a hundred autumns (JlvEma sharadahshhatam)

Let me see a hundred autumns (PashyEma sharadahshhatam)

mOdAma Sharadahshhatam (Let me enjoy a hundred autumns)

ShReNavAma sharadahshhatam (Let me hear a hundred autumns)

ajltAsyAma sharadahshhatam (Let me live invincibly for a hundred autumns)

Importance given to Autumn season can also be seen in the wedding vows. A very important symbol of some Hindu marriages is Mangalasutra (auspicious yellow thread) that is tied by the bridegroom around the neck of bride like a garland. While doing this, the bridegroom says: "Oh! The auspicious one, I am tying this auspicious thread around your neck. It (the thread) is a symbol of my life. You live a hundred autumns (with it).

mAngalyam tantunAnEna mama jlvana hEtuna.

KanTE badhnAmi subhagE tvam jlva sharadahshhatam).

To mark the Autumn season, we have many festivals. We have Dussarah (Sharad navarAtri), dIpAvaLi, Skanda Shashti, Karthigai (Karthik month) festivals, culminating in Bhagavadgita Jayanthi and Vaikunta Ekadashi. Fall festivals are common in different traditions and cultures around the world. Here in the US, we have Halloween and Thanksgiving, which are followed by the Christmas season. Besides, I am sure many of you had some kind of a Fall Fling at your school.

Let us RISE to the message of the FALL season!

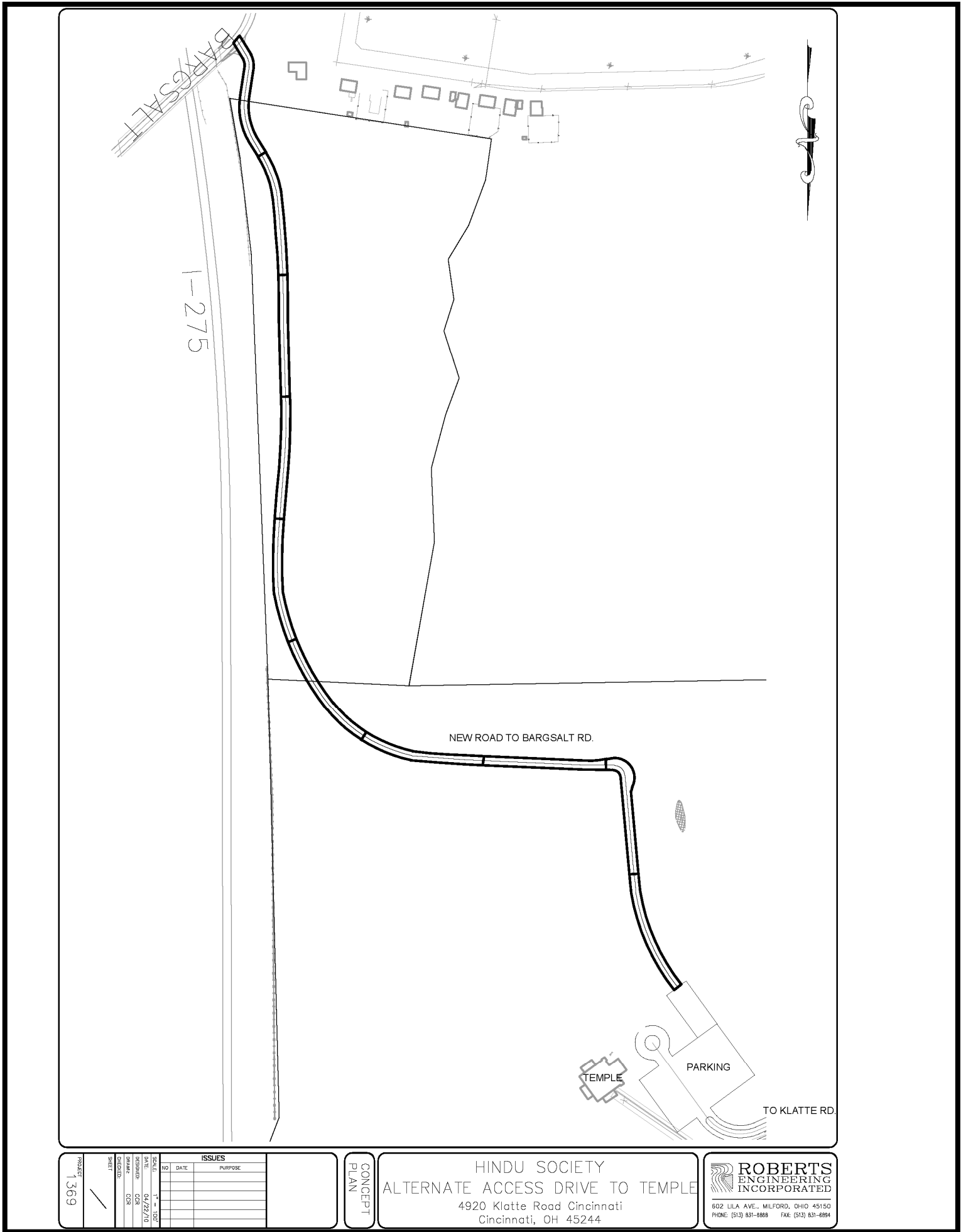

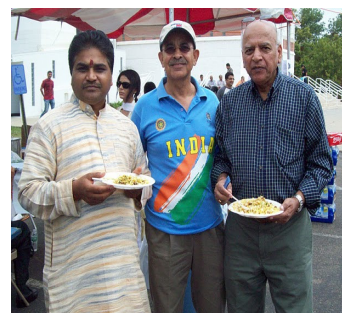
ABOUT BANARAS

Meeting Minutes– September 12, 2010

Absent: Shiv Sharma (Maintenance Committee Chair)

Minutes:

1. The committee decided to issue guidelines for special projects financing.
2. The existing mortgage will be refinanced at lower rates. The loan on the kitchen will be combined with the current mortgage in order to reduce the overall cost to the temple. Laxmi Srivastava, Raj Bodalia and Vijay Sharma will be responsible for the refinancing. However, the fundraising committee has a goal to raise the kitchen related loan in next 5 years or less.
