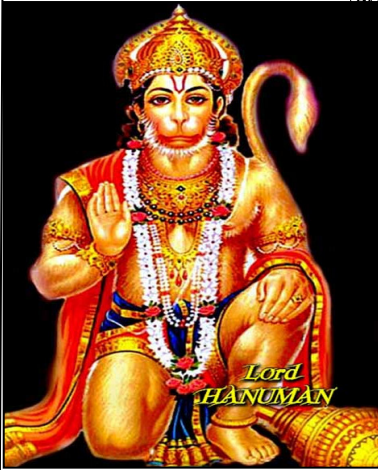

KAILASH MANSAROVAR : A DIVINE JOURNEY



With the blessings of our family, friends, and community from Cincinnati, Ohio, destiny came our way as we started our divine journey to Mount Kailash in Tibet. We were amongst the fortunate few who trekked to the abode of Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati. Our journey began on August 28th from Kathmandu, Nepal. 19 Yatris, along with a crew of experienced guides from Himalayan Glacier Trekking Company, took off in a luxury bus with our packed luggage, tent equipment, and cooking logistics. Several hours into driving through curvy Himalayan roads, we arrived at the border of Nepal-Tibet, in a small village called, Tato-Pani (hot springs). Upon arrival, we discovered the Tibet immigration has closed for the day. We checked into a small hotel and headed for the Hot Springs bath that evening. Over the several days, we traveled through the high plateau of Tibet, enjoying the views, singing and laughing, eating and acclimatizing, and most importantly being with our inner selves. This forbidden land with its rugged terrain, yet with a spiritual heart, is a mysterious place on earth that showers the whole world with peace from its "roof of the world". The religious and adventurous passion took us to these spiritual heights of 19,500 feet trekking and climbing on the foothills of Mount Kailash, Tibet. On September 1st early afternoon, we arrived to the dazzling lake Mansarovar. This creation of God is among the most famous and highest fresh water lakes in the world. The shadow of clouds in the water of Mansarovar Lake appeared like gods watching over and blessing us from heaven. Here we prayed, meditated, and took a holy bath. Our 53 Kilometer Parikrama of Mount Kailash started on the cold morning of September 3rd. Some of us travelled by foot while others on horse. Today, it felt as if the heavens had opened up for us and allowed us to peek inside the world of gods and goddesses. We walked 18 kilometers through the valley guided by Holy Ganges River on our left and shadowed by Mount Kailash on our right. The feeling of today can only be experienced by one and not described...

Over the next few days, we trekked through rugged terrain up to the height of 19,500 feet Dolma-La pass which is the highest point on the parikrama. It was beautifully decorated with arrays of prayer flags. Upon arrival, we prayed and quickly started our journey downhill towards Guari Kund. Next several hours were trekked through the beautiful green valley with streams and surrounded by high snow capped mountain peaks with waterfalls. Upon arrival to our camp sites, we were greeted by our crew with hot tea and dinner. Tonight, we were the neighbor to the Lord's home. We awoke with a smile on our faces like a kid in a candy store...J Back in saddles and on foot; we started toward the completion of final day's parikrama. The laughter and joy echoed through the valley until we reached to our Toyota Land cruisers that awaited our return at the bottom of the valley. We traced our way back to Kathmandu, Nepal. Suddenly, hours before reaching Kathmandu, the sad feeling took over us as we left the spiritual land of Tibet.

What kind of a journey is this? To some it is adventure. To some it is to get away from the crowded world to escape. To some it is a religious site to visit. The journey is not only a trekker's dream, but the place where one can converse with their inner self. In a single journey to Kailash, we travelled several years ahead, experiencing the feeling of pain, struggle, and triumph together. The experience is a complete life. We experienced Kailash-Mansarovar. We celebrated Life!

Meeting Minutes– October 3, 2010

Present: Krutarth Jain (President), Deepak Dixit (Secretary), Prasad Megada (Treasurer), Laxmi Srivastava (Temple Manager), Raneshwar Gupta (Fundraising Committee Chair), Kiran Dayal (Pooja Committee Co-chair), Shiv Sharma (Maintenance Committee Chair)

Anisha Singh (Religious Education Committee Chair), Geeta Mehan (Editor – Aradhana)

Minutes:

- A. Four new carpets (\$200 each) will be acquired as we often run into a shortage of carpets for larger programs.
- B. Additional 50 chairs will be acquired for upstairs as many of the attendees are handicapped.
- C. There need to be very clear set of instructions and guidelines for use of kitchen. Krutarth Jain and Laxmi Srivastava will develop the instructions and signboards for display in the kitchen.
- D. Another gas line in the kitchen may also be considered for safer operation in the kitchen.
- E. Shiv Sharma will look into the consumption of paper products since it has doubled over last year.
- F. The temple has received a technical approval for the Barg Salt Road entrance from Clermont County. Approval is still needed from the Union Township.
- G. An advisory board of past presidents will be constituted to make recommendations on various issues such as financial, legal, and immigration as many issues have a long history and need past perspective. There are a total of 7 past presidents.
- H. Common contact phone numbers and calling trees will be determined in order to respond to emergencies.
- I. Deepak Dixit will investigate use of web based email and document management. This will make the record keeping more secure. Deepak Dixit will investigate it.
- J. The executive committee appreciated the hard work done by the cultural committee for conducting a very successful event “Naach-Sitare.” The committee is considering making this an annual event. The committee will also ensure that this event does not interfere with other major temple events such as the annual mela.
- K. The annual meeting of the Hindu Mandir Executive Conference will be in Houston from Oct 22nd to Oct 24th. Mohan Chopra will represent HSGC in this event.
- L. Satya Majethi and Subodh (?) will be asked to consider local musical talent as well for fund raising events.
- M. Amar Sharma will function as the treasurer during the absence of Prasad Megada who will be visiting India from Oct 17th to mid-December.
- N. The Pooja committee will acquire sweets for up to \$2,000 for Diwali. Sponsorship for this will solicited by the Pooja committee.

Stop Being Who You Were.... Change Into Who You Are

"One always has to know when a stage comes to an end. If we insist on staying longer than the necessary time, we lose the happiness and the meaning of the other stages we have to go through. Closing cycles, shutting doors, ending chapters whatever name we give it, what matters, is to leave in the past the moments of life that have finished.

Did you lose your job? Has a loving relationship come to an end? Did you leave your parents' house? Gone to live abroad? Has a long-lasting friendship ended all of sudden? You can spend a long time wondering why this has happened. You can tell yourself you won't take another step until you find out why certain things that were so important and so solid in your life have turned into dust, just like that. But such an attitude will be awfully stressing for everyone involved: your parents, your husband or wife, your friends, your children, your sister, everyone will be finishing chapters, turning over new leaves, getting on with life, and they will all feel bad seeing you at a standstill.

None of us can be in the present and the past at the same time, not even when we try to understand the things that happen to us. What has passed will not return: we cannot forever be children, late adolescents, sons that feel guilt or rancour towards our parents, lovers who day and night relive an affair with someone who has gone away and has not the least intention of coming back. Things pass, and the best we can do is to let them really go away.

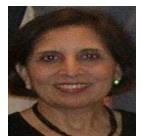
That is why it is so important (however painful it maybe!) to destroy souvenirs, move, give lots of things away to orphanages, sell or donate the books you have at home. Everything in this visible world is a manifestation of the invisible world, of what is going on in our hearts and getting rid of certain memories also means making some room for other memories to take their place. Let things go. Release them. Detach yourself from them.

Nobody plays this life with marked cards, so sometimes we win and sometimes we lose. Do not expect anything in return, do not expect your efforts to be appreciated, your genius to be discovered, your love to be understood. Stop turning on your emotional television to watch the same program over and over again, the one that shows how much you suffered from a certain loss: that is only poisoning you, nothing else. Nothing is more dangerous than not accepting love relationships that are broken off, work that is promised but there is no starting date, decisions that are always put off waiting for the "ideal moment." Before a new chapter has begun, the old one has to be finished: tell yourself that what has passed will never come back. Remember that there was a time when you could live without that thing or that person. Nothing is irreplaceable. A habit is not a need. This may sound so obvious, it may even be difficult, but it is very important.

Closing cycles. Not because of pride, incapacity or arrogance, but simply because that no longer fits your life. Shut the door, change the record, clean the house, shake off the dust.

I read the above and was very much impressed by the messageI hope you will be too. Take stock of your life and move on to the NEW IMPROVED YOU.....it is very much in keeping with the philosophy preached by Lord Krishna.....the past is gone....The future is yet to come. the present is here....be in the MOMENT. Let go of 2010 with grace and get ready to embrace 2011.



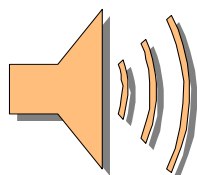
To give you an idea of how great his poetry is, let me quote the following stanza from his book:

Bringing fragrance in life, latent powers to tap!

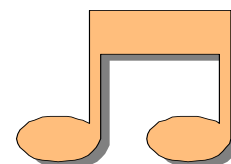

The book can be purchased from the Gift Shop located at the main entrance to the Hindu Temple.

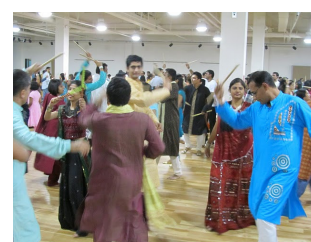
