HSGC – Executive Committee

Meeting Minutes-February 5, 2012

Executive Committee: Deepak Dixit (President), Ambi Balasubramaniam (Vice President), Prasad Megada (Treasurer), Prade ep Gupta (Secretary), Asit Saha (Cultural Committee), Je etu Patel (Long Range Planning), Kiran Dayal* (Pooja Committee), Manish Srivastava (Fundraising Committee), Rakesh Patel (Maintenance Committee), Sandeep Gupta* (Editor-Aradhana), and Vinit Rastogi (Religious Education Committee) * Not present

Meeting Minutes:

- 1. The February meeting was held on February 5, 2012. Everyone was present except Kiran Dayal and Sandeep Gupta who were out of town for personal reasons.
 - a. After completing the construction, the Temple has received occupancy permit for the Library.
 - b. County work is complete but the contractor has lot of work remaining. Temple civil engineer will walk through with contractor to see if the restorative work has been completed.
- 2. January meeting minutes were approved by all attendees.
- 3. Deepak Dixit stated that the general fund balance is at a critically low level. This balance must be raised. We need to raise at least 40K urgently to bring the balance at a comfort level.
- 4. On the same topic, Jeetu Patel was accompanied by Mr. Vinod, the fund raising organizer for Balaji Marg Project. Mr. Vinod was requested to help raise funds for HSGC. The purpose of the event was to raise funds for Balaji Marg portion of the Marg Project and if any fund left, to donate to the temple general account. He needed all the support he can get from the temple but he did not request any financial support from the temple.
- 5. Holi is on March 8 but the Holi celebration at Temple is on March 10, 2012.
- 6. Kiran Dayal and Rakesh Patel will start their respective inventory which will complete by 6/30/2012.
- 7. Yoga classes have been started, need more participation. The committee is working hard on helping Yoga program and has revised pricing structure to increase/attract greater participation.
- 8. For the upcoming Holi program, the last date to submit names for program participation is Feb 20, 2012. There are total of 25 items planned (5 single and 20 group)
- 9. For a brain storming on fund raising, a separate EC meeting has been scheduled for February 19th.
- 10. There is an issue with Emergency Evacuation and Contingency Plan (EEACP) or emergency access and evacuation at the temple. Pradeep Gupta will lead this project with help from Asit Saha and Prem Garg.
- 11. Need to schedule safety walkthrough with special emphasis on Fire Extinguishers, sprinkler system, emergency exits, and training on using emergency equipment.
- 12. There are currently three email database with separate individuals, Deepak Dixit will lead the effort in combining all three email databases into one.
- 13. According to Vinit Rastogi, Anisha Singh is doing marvelous job in the area of youth activities and he does not want to disturb the operation. However, he proposed following three projects:
 - a. Hinduism and Gita Discussion Koti Srikrishna (12 and up)
 - b. Art and Craft Lessons Neha Shettigar
 - c. Chin maya Mission Get them involved
- 14. All roof leaks have been stopped. Need to establish preventive maintenance schedule for the temple.
- 15. Pt. Kailash Ji Sharma has been appointed Chief Priest of the Temple and EC members have unanimously agreed to send him to the 1st Hindu Mandir Priests' Conference 2012 to be held on April 27-28, 2012 in Pittsburgh, PA.
- 16. Deepak Dixit, once again, emphasized the use of Document Management System (DMS) for all Temple documents and new email system for sending and receiving temple emails.
- 17. Next meeting will be on March 4, 2012 at 10:30am.

Lesson Plan 5: Religious Books in Hindu Dharma (हिन्दू धर्म शास्त्र)

For Children 9 years to 14 years

Prepared by Renu Gupta

Every religion has holy book, they set the basic foundation and teachings of that religion. Usually each religion has one book as authority, like Bible to Christians or Quran to Muslims etc.

As you all know Hindu Dharma is one of the oldest living religions (Dharma) and has been blessed with many saints or Rishis who have contributed in the growth of the Hindu Dharma in thousands of year. Thus we don't have any one book, which can be addressed as only one holy book of Hindus.

We divide our holy books in several categories.

- 1) Scriptures (Shruti) (**獨त)**
 - a. Scriptures are called as direct voice of GOD.
 - b. Saints and Rishis have realized the great knowledge of GOD thru the Dhyan (meditation) or Tup (Penance)
 - c. The shlokas (मंत्र) are the voice of GOD, they were not written by saints, but saints saw the Mantra in mediation.
 - d. Scriptures are the supreme body of Hindu Dharma

There four Vedas चार वेद

- 1) Rig Veda ऋग वेद
- 2) Athrav Veda अथर्व वेद
- 3) Yajur Veda यजुर वेद
- 4) Sam Veda साम वेद

(All Vedas contain 20000 sholkas all together and have some section of Karmkand कर्म कांड (Yagna and other rituals) and Gyan Kand जान कांड (Knowledge of GOD and Universe which also contains knowledge of science etc.), the word Ved means "To Know", Vedas are also called "Shruti" means "Heard by GOD"

Other scriptures:

Upanishad, Aranyak, Brahaman, Sutra and Mantra Sanhita are the further extension or description of Knowledge of the Vedas.

(उपनिषद, आरण्यक ,सूत्र एवं मंत्र संहिता)

Upanishad: उपनिषद

The word Upanishad means sitting close to Guru and attaining the knowledge and wisdom. Upanishads are one of the most important scriptures of Hindu Philosophy, they are also called Vedanta. Upanishads explain very well the concept of Brahaman (निराकार भगवान्), the formless, universal all-pervading Bhagwan and how to know HIM.

Originally there were 108 Upanishads, but only 12 are available. Some important Upanishads are 1) Ishovasy Upanishad ईशावास्य उपनिषद

- 2) Isho Upanishad इषो उपनिषद
- 3) Katho Upanishad कठो उपनिषद
- 4) Keno Upanishad केनो उपनिषद and more

Shrimad Bhagwad Geeta (श्रीमद भगवद गीता) is one of the most recent scripture has preaching of Bhagwan Krishna during the war at Kurushetra. "Bhagwad Geeta"means "the Song of GOD". This scripture contains 700 Sholkas and only 18 Chapters. It talks about KarmaYog, GyaanYog and BhaktiYog. Geeta is the most popular scripture and has been translated almost in all the languages of the world. This the shortest Book in among Hindu Holy Books.

There are four Up Vedas

- 1) Ayur Veda आयुर्वेद (Knowledge of Medicine)
- 2) Dhanur Veda धन्वेंद (Knowledge of War)
- 3) Gandharv Veda गंधवंवेद (Knowledge of Music)
- 4) Shilp Shastra शिल्प शास्त्र (Knowledge of science, machines and architect)

There are many other scriptures

- 1) Manu Smriti (मनु स्मृति)is another important scripture which is called Law of Karma for Hindus. This is more like explain everybody's duties in the society.
- 2) Natya shastra **नाट्य शास्त्र (**Knowledge of dance) by Bharat muni
- 3) Panini Vyakaran पाणिनि व्याकरण (knowledge of Grammar and linguistics) by Rishi Panini
- 4) Patnjali Yoga Sutra पतंजिल योग सूत्र (Knowledge of eight Yoga) by rishi Patanjali
- 5) Neeti Shastra **नीति शास्त्र (**Knowledge of code and conducts) Many known neeti shastras are Vidur Neeti, Shukra Neeti and Chankya Neeti. (विद्र नीति , शुक्र नीति एवं चाणक्य नीति)

Smruti (स्मृति) (Stories of God, Ishwar and Devtas) (PURANAS) (पुराण)

The word "Smruti" means "remembered or in the memory". In this category we have several puranas, where ancient knowledge is explained in the story form. These books also have deep Gyan (Knowledge). There are hundreds in the number though only few are available.

- 1) The most important Puran is Bhagwat Mahapuran (भागवद महापुराण)which has 18000 shlokas and it has detailed story of Bhagwan Shri Krishna.
- 2) Other Puranas are stories of Bhagwan Shiva, Vishnu, Narad Muni ji, other Avataar, Garud and many other Dewtas.

<u>History (Itihaas) (इतिहास)</u>

We have two very important books of Hindu Dharma which is called history, because they have dated material, facts and stories.

- 1) Ramayana (रामायण)written by Maharishi Valmiki (Story of Bhagwan Ram Chandra Ji)
- 2) Mahabharata (**महाभारत**) written by Mahrishi Ved Vyas (Story of pandavas, Kouravas and Bhagwan Shri Krishna) Mahabharat is one of the largest books with 100000 Sholkas (verses) all together.






