

The month of March was exceptional in many ways. We had many notable and highly successful events. I am even more excited about the many things ahead of us.

Dr. Anant Ram Bhati passed away unexpectedly on February 17, 2012. However, he left a lasting legacy for our community and our Hindu Temple of Greater Cincinnati.

Dr. Bhati and his wife Shammi arrived in Cincinnati in July, 1971. They became actively involved in the activities of a very small group of Indian community. They participated in the first Puja (Vasant Panchami) organized by several families at the home of Dr. Kapildeo and Kiran Sinha. Since then, monthly Puja was performed by the late Dr. Gangadhar Chouhury in different homes including Dr. Bhati's by rotation. As the group became larger, the Puja was moved to the

basement of the First National Bank, Ludlow. The first meeting with Mr. Ram Jindal, Dr. Nageah Divedi was held in Dr. Bhati's office to raise fund for the purchase the old house as Temple on Martin Luther King Drive. Dr. Bhati was a very active, generous and hands on person. On every Sunday, after the Puja, Dr. Bhati used to help children perform Arti and receive Ashirvad from the full time professional Priest of the Temple.

As the community became larger and the members decided to build our present Temple, Dr. Bhati took leadership in fundraising. He was very persuasive and good at fund raising. According to Mrs. Bhati, Dr. Bhati and his fund raising team met most evening every week, develop plans and knocked door to door and persuade families to make large donation for the new, most unique and inclusive Temple with all original 12 deities of equal dimension on the same platform and only Temple to have installed the most sacred sound and unifying divine symbol OM at the center of the deity platform.

More recently, Dr. and Mrs. Bhati sponsored the Luri festival at the Temple. Last year after a special Puja, Dr. Bhati challenged the devotees to match their donations and pledges for the support of the Temple. After the installation of the spectacular Garbhagrihas, Dr. Bhati spoke at length with the Garbhagriha project manager, Mr. Rameshwar Dayal, his intent to organize a large fund drive for Temple projects by inviting his doctor and other friends soon after his Coroner's election.

Dr. Bhati always extended a helping hand at the time of need in the community. He was there after the "unnatural death" of an Indian graduate student and for the visiting elderly parents from India desperately in need of kidney transplant for their young son and more as well as comforting families in the community at the time of sadness such as death of a loved one.

Dr. Bhati was professionally very successful and received many well deserved recognitions. He used his influence locally and at the state level to promote the visibility and respect for the Indian community through appointment on professional Boards and Trustees of several state universities.

Our community is very grateful for Dr. Bhati's many contributions and the community will remember his many good memories and friend-ship.

May his departed soul rest in peace and may Lord Almighty bless his loving family at their time of grief and great loss.






