Update from the President

Namaskar,

First of all, I want to express our condolences at the senseless shooting at the Sikh Gurdwara in Milwaukee. Our hearts go out to the victims as well as the wider Sikh community. Please keep all of them in your prayers!

The month of July was again a very hectic month. Major events included Jagannath ji's Bahuda Yatra, community Satya Narayan Pooja with a target of 108 families performing this pooja jointly, Murugan Abhishekam, and Mata ki Chowki. The Murugan Abhishekam also had the Rath Yatra for the first time. This was a first not just for our temple, but for any temple in USA. We also had Acharya Taranand ji, a highly revered teacher of Kriya Yoga, visit the temple.

A major concern for last few years has been the deteriorating state of the road from the Klatte Road entrance to the temple and the parking lot. What was thought to be a \$30K work was revised by contractors to \$60K to \$150K. This prompted another search and fortunately, we were able to locate the right contractor. Eventually, through this smart groundwork, we got the road repaired and resurfaced for \$18K. We also got the side road completely redone for an additional \$8K. It meant that we had to exceed our available funds by almost \$8K. I would appeal all of you to help us fill this gap by contributing generously to the Road Maintenance fund by contacting Shri Raneshwar Gupta.

Another vexing issue has been the roof. We completed major maintenance of the roof last year and early this year. We are still seeing some isolated leaks from the roof. The roofing contractror has been working at fixing the leaks, but the reality is that our roof is more than 17 years old now and it is at the end of its useful life. We need to replace the roof very soon and need to start setting aside funds for this purpose. Again, I am appealing to all of you to contribute generously to the temple so that we can embark on this project soon. No one amongst us would live with a leaking roof in our own homes. I am sure that we would not want to see a leaking roof in the home of our gods.

As I have stated in my prior updates, a great way to contribute to the temple is to enroll in the Kroger Rewards program as well as use the Office Depot Rewards program. These programs allow you to contribute to the temple while realizing substantial savings through these programs. We are also coming up with other innovative fundraisers that will appeal to you, save you money, and contribute to the temple as well. One such program is with Rogers Jewelers. Please see the details of this program in this issue of Aradhana.

We have also started work on installation of new electric poles in front of the temple. There will be two poles with 4 heads of light each. The lights on these heads will be very powerful. This will help in all round illumination of the front and sides of the temple as well as the parking lot. We are actively working on the elevator project as well. We are getting quotation from vendors and raising funds to make this project happen very soon. This will be an invaluable addition to the temple that will facilitate movement of the handicapped and the elderly throughout the temple. We are also concurrently working on planning the Marg project and raising funds. This will result in a new access to the temple from the Barg salt Road.

We are eagerly looking forward to the Mela - "Taste of India." This time, we have combined the highly acclaimed dance competition Naach-Sitare with the Mela. We have already exceeded the limit set on number of dances for the competition. There will be a significant number of vendors as well. The grand finale will be a fireworks show by Rozzi, the people behind the Labor Day fireworks. Please be sure to bring your family and extended circle of friends for this event. It will be a great way to introduce our culture to your non-Indian friends as well.

I am also extremely excited about a unique program that we are bringing to Cincinnati. The famous Bollywood playback and devotional singer, Anuradha Paudwal, is coming to Cincinnati (only) for a fundraising concert for the temple on Saturday, Nov 3. Please mark the date on your calendars and be sure to attend.

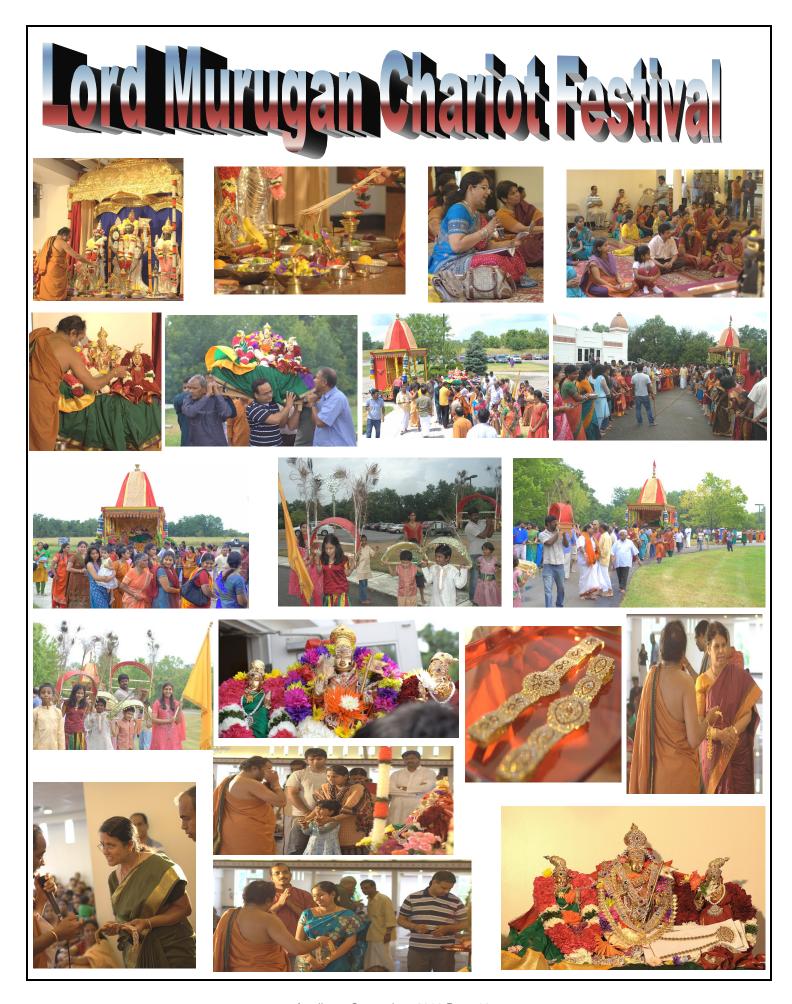

Nutrition, exercise, and stress management are the three things that we can control in our daily life to achieve good health. Good nutrition includes picking the right foods at the right time, preparing and eating it healthfully, knowing how processing affects nutrients in foods, and including herbs and spices for their health benefits. In this and future columns, I will try to address the challenges in achieving good nutrition in our daily life, focusing specifically on the Indian diet. Let's first consider grains. In the American diet, grains play a secondary role to meat, which is the focus of a meal. However in an Indian diet, grains play a vital role, making up a bigger portion of the meal. Chapattis, rice, dosas, idlis, rotis, etc., make up the bulk of the diet and soak up our subjis. Meats, when eaten traditionally, are eaten in small amounts, only a few times a week. However, with the move away from India, adults and children of Indian descent, include other foods in their daily diets, e.g. breakfast may consist of starches like cereal, toast, or waffles. Pasta, pizza, and other starchy ethnic foods are also popular. Diabetes, high cholesterol, and heart diseases are seen often in the Indian population. When diagnosed with these diseases, the diet recommendation is to decrease refined starches and sugars, change to healthy oils, and to exercise. So how do we prepare and eat grains in a healthy way? The USDA food guidelines recommend that at least 50-75% of our diet comes from whole grains. White flour, white rice. and de-germed corn meal are the main sources of refined grains in our diets. When grains are refined, their outer husks and bran are removed and what we eat is essentially the starchy portion, known as the endosperm. Many vitamins and minerals, and fiber, are removed in this process known as de-germination. Some of the nutrients are added back due to government regulations. However, the quality of refined grains, even with added nutrients, is very poor. The starchy grain is easily converted to sugars in our body, and this increases the risk of inflammatory health problems like diabetes and arthritis. It is healthier to eat the whole grains in the first place. Grains like ragi, jowar, bajra, quinoa, and amaranth amongst others, are usually not refined, and make good substitutes for refined grains. Eating a variety of grains will also provide us with nutrients that we would not normally get when we eat just rice or wheat everyday.

One frequent complaint about using whole grains is that it takes too long to cook (20 minutes for white rice vs. 60 minutes for brown rice). Soaking the grains overnight, will not only help with faster cooking times, but is also beneficial for health, as it makes the nutrients in the grains more absorbable by our body. Soaking rice overnight, atta flour in yogurt or water overnight, and sprouting beans are all good examples. Think about it as a little time investment in your health and plan the food preparation ahead of time.

So next time you eat, use brown rice instead of white, and whole wheat flour (look for 100% whole wheat), instead of white flour. If children or family members refuse to eat whole grains, introduce it gradually into their diets. Use \(\frac{1}{4}\) of brown to \(\frac{3}{4}\) of white rice for two weeks and gradually increase to \(\frac{1}{2}\) and \(\frac{1}{2}\) and so on, so that over the course of two to three months, you have switched to all brown rice. Use whole wheat flour to make Naan (it comes out just as fluffy and soft as white naan). Use brown rice or quinoa to make idlis and dosas. Use guinoa or amaranth flour in addition to wheat, to make chapattis. When eating out, ask for brown rice as an option. Restaurants cater to customer demand and if more people request brown rice, it may be provided as an option. When eating cereal, toasts, or non-traditional foods, use 100% whole grain products (without added sugar). Use Pasta made with 100% whole wheat instead of white pasta.

- Long Term Projects For Temple fund raising, a number of options (Santini Roy Music Program, Sargam group from Louisville, and Anuradha Paudwal) were discussed. Deepak and Manish will look into these options and present to next EC meeting for consideration.
- 6. <u>Flag</u> We have collected sufficient funds for the Flag project; Temple will pay for the pole and the flags. Need light for the flag which can be mounted on the current electric pole.
 - a. There are some rules and regulations about flying American Flag which will be followed up before proceeding with this project.
- 7. <u>Front Garden</u> Installation of fountain was discussed and due to financial constraints. EC is evaluating the options regarding installing the fountain at this time.
- 8. <u>Elevator</u> EC thinks elevator is necessary for the temple and must be given priority. Additional quotes will be solicited before making any decisions.
- 9. Expenses In future, all expenses must be authorized by EC in advance before committing.
- 10. <u>Finances</u> Currently the Temple has limited amount in general fund which must be controlled until additional funds are collected.
- 11. <u>Security System</u> Deepak and Rakesh will schedule a meeting with Security committee (Meena Mehta, Vinay Kumar), and address current concerns.
- 12. Next meeting will be on August 5, 2012 at 10:30am. The General Body meeting has also been scheduled for August 5, 2012.

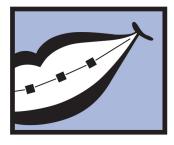
