- 15. No song will be repeated (even in medley).
- 16. Audition for all items will be held on November 4th 2012 at Ankur from 5:00 pm onwards. Details to follow.
- 17. More information on tickets and rehearsal dates to follow.
- 18. Changes in the song selection and participants are not allowed once the entry is registered.
- 19. Each group should have a separate choreographer and manager.
- 20. Each performance should be assigned one person (manager) who deals with all the communication with the Ankur Cultural Director, Kamini Jain.
- 21. Performers wishing to use Ankur for practice times must sign up for a specific time and every person practicing at Ankur must be a member. We will be curtailing practice times to accommodate most number of participants.
- 22. Each group using Ankur must take the responsibility to leave the premises in the condition they found it in.
- 23. Once the program order had been decided, we will not be able to accommodate requests for changes. We will also not be able to change any of the particulars in an item after it has been submitted.
- 24. The item introduction should be able to be announced in less than a minute.
- 25. All entries and exits must be from the stage. The aisles in the auditorium may not be used.
- 26. All inquiries and communication should be via email.
- 27. The committee reserves the right to select items based on, but not limited to, time, logistics, and maximum community participation.




