

Significance of Shraddha

The dark fortnight of Ashwin Month is known as Mahalaya Paksha/ Pitrapaksha or the fortnight especially sacred for offering oblations to the departed ancestors. The last day of this period, the new moon day (Amavasya), is considered as the most important day in the year for performing obsequies and rites (or in simple terms offerings to our dearly departed ancestors). The Shraddh performed during Pitru Paksha are not funeral ceremonies. They are Yagyas for the Pitru, worship of the ancestors as deities. They are different from the worship of the God. Shraddha is mainly performed for three generations of Pitrus, namely the father, the grandfather, and the great grandfather. When performed for all the ancestors, performer's family gets benefit from it.



TULSI GABBARD FIRST HINDU-AMERICAN CONGRESSWOMAN

Congresswoman Tulsi Gabbard of Hawai'i's Second Congressional District took Oath of Office on her personal the Bhagavad Gita on Jan. 3. As a practicing Hindu, the Congresswoman became the first Hindu-American ever to be sworn in to the U.S. Congress.

"I chose to take the oath of office with my personal copy of the Bhagavad-Gita because its teachings have inspired me to strive to be a servant-leader, dedicating my time and energy on a daily basis in the service to others (karma yoga).

"My Gita has been a tremendous source of inner peace and strength through many tough challenges in life, including being in the midst of death and turmoil while serving our country in the Middle East. When I was deployed to Iraq, the only real shelter for me was my bhakti yoga practice and the Bhagavad-Gita's message of the eternality of the soul and God's unconditional love," she said. Yoga passes secularism test in US

July 4, 2013 WASHINGTON: <u>Yoga</u> enthusiasts in the US got a big boost this week when a California judge ruled that the practice which originated in India is now a "distinctly American cultural phenomenon," while dismissing complaints from some parents that teaching it to school children amounted to "an unconstitutional promotion of Eastern religions."

Weeks of testimony from yoga practitioners and opponents, including live demonstration in courtroom of poses taught to children, came to a convoluted finale on Monday when <u>Judge John Mayer</u> agreed that yoga "at its roots is religious," but pronounced that the kind introduced by a school district near San Diego, which was the subject of the litigation, passed the test of secularism. "A reasonable student would not objectively perceive that Encinitas School District yoga does advance or promote religion." he said.

Parents of some children had sued to stop the school district from teaching yoga maintaining it is a religious practice that surreptitiously promoted Hinduism. Funded with \$533,000 from the K.Pattabhi Jois Foundation, which is backed by Jois acolytes, hedge-fund billionaire Paul Tudor Jones II and his wife Sonia, the school district introduced a three-year pilot yoga program in 2011, with twice a week classes in addition to regular physical education.

A Hindu Goddess Arrives To Bless Embassy Row

Embassy Row — otherwise known as Massachusetts Avenue — in Washington, D.C., is decorated with flags of every nation, flying in front of impressive embassy buildings. In front of the embassies, there are often statues of national heroes. Winston Churchill graces the grounds of the British Embassy. Outside the Indian Embassy, Mahatma Gandhi looks as though he's in full stride, clad in loincloth and sandals. And now, there's a Hindu goddess. Saraswati just arrived. She stands in a garden in front of Indonesia's embassy, glowing white and gold, with her four arms upraised.

Indonesian Ambassador Dino Patti Djalal says the goal was to stand out from the other embassies. "I think this is exactly what we wanted to do with Massachusetts Avenue," he says, "add something that would jazz it up."

Saraswati is the goddess of learning and wisdom, Djalal says. At her feet are three children studying. It was crafted by three Balinese sculptors in three weeks. Her expression is beatific. "This would be the same expression that you would see in Hindu goddesses throughout Bali," Djalal says. "A face of calm ... blessing those who are seeing her." Although Indonesia is home to the largest population of Muslims in the world, Djalal chose a symbol of the Hindu religion for the embassy in Washington. "One of the most famous, if not the most famous, islands in Indonesia is Bali," he says. "And Bali is a Hindu enclave in Muslimmajority Indonesia. And I think it says a lot about our respect for religious freedom that the statue in front of the country with the largest Muslim population is a Hindu statue." [Copyright 2013 NPR]
