That's just for starters. You can then begin to pray for others, and their well-being. Pray for your family, your job, & your co-workers. Pray for your enemies & your competition. Most of all, pray for the world and world peace. In fact, pray for everything you can think of. When you pray you instantly raise your personal vibration to a higher & more harmonious energy pattern.

This higher vibration has a healing effect on your physical and emotional body. It calms your anxiety, soothes your nerves, and eases your tension. It has helped relieve high blood pressure, lift depression, & cure sickness, although the scientists aren't sure how.



Thanks to the generosity of the HSGC members and the Indian community in the Tri-State and Oxford, OH area, this year the total cash collected was \$8123. The total collection (including three contributions that were made through the United Way campaign), is to be handed over to the officials of the Freestore Foodbank. This Organization is the largest emergency food and services provider to the homeless, unemployed and working poor families in the tri-state area.

Every year since 1988 GFD has collected cash and canned food for Freestore Foodbank. Over the years the Indian community has donated cash and food worth nearly \$167,000 to the Freestore Foodbank.

















