HAPPY FATHER"S DAY: Some thoughts:

The first is setting an example of excellence for our children - because if we want to set high expectations for them, we've got to set high expectations for ourselves. It's great if you have a job; it's even better if you have a college degree. It's a wonderful to have a home and family, but don't just sit in the house and watch "Sports Center" all weekend long. That's why so many children are growing up in front of the television. As fathers and parents, we've got to spend more time with them, and help them with homework, replace the video game or the remote control with a book once in awhile. That's how we build that foundation.

It's up to Fathers to instill this ethic of excellence in our children.; to say to their daughters, don't ever let images on TV tell you what you are worth. Dream without limit and reach for those goals. It's up to Dads to tell their sons, those songs on the radio may glorify violence, but in my house we live glory to achievement, self respect, and hard work. It's up to us to set these high expectations. And that means meeting those expectations ourselves. That means setting examples of excellence in our own lives.

Dads need to pass along the value of empathy to children....the ability to stand in somebody else's shoes; to look at the world through their eyes. Sometimes it's so easy to get caught up in "us," and forget about our obligations to one another and to be kind....Our young boys and girls see that. They see when you are respecting, ignoring or mistreating your wife. They see when you are inconsiderate at home; or when you are distant; or when you are thinking only of yourself. Responsibility as Fathers is to show your kids that you're not strong by putting other people down - you're strong by lifting them up.

We do what we can to build our house upon the sturdiest rock. And when the winds come, and the rains fall, we keep faith that our Father will be there to guide us, and watch over us, and protect us, and lead His children through the darkest of storms into light of a better day. May God Bless you and your children. Enjoy Fatherhood and give it your best!!!





When he was confident enough, he grabbed it with his fingers and threw it out of the restaurant.

Sipping my coffee and watching the amusement, the antenna of my mind picked up a few thoughts and started wondering, was the cockroach

responsible for their histrionic behavior?

If so, then why was the waiter not disturbed?

He handled it near to perfection, without any chaos.

It is not the cockroach, but the inability of the ladies to handle the disturbance caused by the cockroach that disturbed the ladies.

I realized that, it is not the shouting of my father or my boss or my wife that disturbs me, but it's my inability to handle the disturbances caused by their shouting that disturbs me.

It's not the traffic jams on the road that disturbs me, but my inability to handle the disturbance caused by the traffic jam that disturbs me.

More than the problem, it's my reaction to the problem that creates chaos in my life.

Lessons learnt from the story: -

I understood, I should not react in life. I should always respond.

The women reacted, whereas the waiter responded.

Reactions are always instinctive whereas responses are always well thought of, just and right to save a situation from going out of hands, to avoid cracks in relationship, to avoid taking decisions in anger, anxiety, stress or hurry. A beautiful way to understand......Life

In Greater Cincinnati area most of the companies are in the midst of raising funds for United Way from their employees. 

HSGC NAACH SITARE Dance Competition (2014) Rules and Regulations

- 1. The total number of entries will be limited to fifty and will be taken on a first come first basis.
- 2. The Committee reserves the right to select/reject the items based on number/types of songs and other factors of the entries received. The Committee reserves the right to define the awards by category and age groups.
- 3. The Committee would like to stress appropriateness in costume, song and dance style that is consistent with the temple setting and with the Indian heritage. Entries not meeting these criteria may be disqualified.
- 4. Repetition of the same song will not be permitted. Before submitting the entry, please check the song selection with the Cultural Chair at hsgcnaachsitare@gmail.com.
- 5. One individual can participate in one solo and one group performance ONLY.
- 6. To qualify for a group entry, the minimum number of participants required is three.
- 7. Each team needs to assign an adult manager who will be the sole contact person from registration till the performance day. Entries can only be registered by an adult.
- 8. Bailing out of the competition is allowed only 30 days prior to the competition. No shows and last minute cancellation will affect your participation in subsequent years.
- 9. For managers/choreographer with multiple entries, each entry should be sent in a separate email.
- 10. The category (Minor/Junior/Senior and Adult) will be determined by the oldest performer in the group.
- 11. Timings and Scheduling each dance item will be limited to 5 minutes. If the time limit is exceeded, the entry will not qualify for awards. Additionally, only 1 minute is allowed for stage preparation (includes general introductions) before the dance performance, and only 1 minute allowed after performance to clean the stage.
- 12. Music the music in the mp3 format needs to be emailed to hsgcnaachsitare@gmail.com before 31st July 2014 with the item number (will be provided to you once the entry is accepted) written in the Subject line of the email. For medley, only one file (with multiple songs) will be accepted do not send multiple files for medley. Do bring your song on a CD as a backup on the day of the performance.
- 13. Props and Lighting props hanging from the ceiling will not be allowed; use of large props needs to be clarified at the time of registration. Only the performers can handle props on stage. Fireworks, confetti or fog machines will not be permitted.
- 14. The teams are not allowed to approach the judges before/during and after the competition; the judges' decision will be final; no grievances will be entertained
- 15. Judges will score each competitor in the following five categories (worth 20 points each):
- Choreography
- II. Technique and Facial Expression
- III. Originality
- IV. Stage Presence
- V. Costume




