

Pandit Jayant Kumar Mohapatra resigned Jan month end due to personal reasons.

Number of children attending the Hindu religious education Sunday classes have been increasing steadily and now stands at 20+.

Treasurer mailed the 2015 tax statements to the donors on Feb 2 2016. Temple fully paid the 2016 property tax in advance.

Executive committee approved the \$200.00 salary raise for Greg Smith in consideration of multiple services including support to temple website, electrical, mechanical, audio, and visual and property maintenance.

A new security system had installed in the temple.

Temple is looking for more youth volunteers in conducting the Holi function. Temple is looking forward to conduct the variety cultural programs on Mar 26 2015. All devotees are welcome to make the program successful.

New Brick wall engraving will be starting in April 2016. The donor names for the new brick wall list were published in the Feb 2016 Aaradhana. Renu Kotwal, chair, membership, and fund raising have taken the initiative to make it successful.

Executive committee emphasized on the safety needs in kitchen, and in other utility areas. Appropriate warning and informational signs will be posted. Contractors have been identified for the work; they will complete the work in April.

Ramcharit Manas Akhand Ramayan Path

Mangal Bhavan Amangal Haari, Dravahu Su Dashrath Ajir Bihari.

May that home of bliss and bane of woe take compassion on me;

He who sports in the courtyard of King Dashratha.

Shri Ramcharitmanas or Ramayan is an epic written by great poet Tulsidas who also known as Goswami Tulsidas. He was a multi-faceted person. A Hindu poet- saint, reformer and also philosopher of 16th Century famed for his devotion towards Lord Rama. Formerly, the Ramayana was written by Sage Valmiki in Sanskrit language. Tulsidas was acclaimed during his lifetime to be a reincarnation of Valmiki, the composer of the original Ramayana in Sanskrit. Shri Ram Charit Manas is a great Epic written in local language called Avadhi Bhasha spoken surrounding Ayodhya the birth place of Shri Rama, which depicts the Life of Lord Rama who was the 7th incarnation of Lord Vishnu. Lord Rama is also known as "Maryada Purushottam" means preeminent Purush (personality). Lord Rama is the impeccable Avatar of Lord Vishnu and has been described as the embodiment of Truth, Morality, an Ideal Son, an Ideal Husband and overall an Ideal King. Lord Rama is Prayed upon as the:

One who eradicates all types of adversity and agony of Jiva (living beings); who bestows all types of favor, honor and wealth; by just looking at whom, the world feel very pleased; to that Shri Rama, I bow again and again "

This whole epic of Ramcharitmanas is divided into seven chapters known as Kaands each kaand describes story of Lord Rama from childhood to throughout his life The story of Shri Raam is related in the Raamayana which literally means the journey of Shri Rama. Here is a wonderful Sloka that explains the epic of Ramayan.

"Aadau Ram-tapo-vanadi-gamanam hatva mrigam kanchanam, Vaidehi-haranam jatayu-marnam sugriva-sambhashanam . Bali -nirdalanam samudra -taranam Lankapuri-dahanam ; Pashchad-ravana-kumbhakarna hananam etaddhi -Ramayanam"

Ramayana, the story of Rama, narrates Rama's banishing to the forest, the killing of the golden deer, the abduction of Sita,the passing of Jatayu, conversations with Sugrieva, destruction of Bali, Crossing of the ocean, destruction of the city of Lanka by fire and the killings of the demons, Ravana and Kumbhakarana.

Seven Kaand Names:

Baal Kaand Ayodhya Kaand Aranya Kaand Kishkindha Kaand Sunderkaand Lanka Kaand Uttar Kaand

According to the Hindus, a mere recital of this great Epic Ramayana is considered highly Auspicious and is enough effective to remove various obstacles. It is considered that the benefits of reciting this Epic are increased manifold if it is recited non-stop from starting to end without any break in between which takes time of approximately 24 hours. This recitation is known as "Akhand Ramayana" means "Complete / Full" (without any kind of break).

The Akhand Ramyan path provides Peace, Prosperity & Happiness in the family, creates a very Pious and Divine Atmosphere at a place and prevents from unknown and unexpected harms dangers especially regarding the health. It should be done on an Auspicious beginning of any new venture like starting of a Business, Entering a New House (Grih Pravesh), Birth of a Child, Marriage Ceremony, to pay homage and tributes to Lord Rama on Rama Navami which is considered as the Day of Birth of Lord Rama as per Hindu Mythology. Hindu Society of greater Cincinnati organizes Akhand Ramayan path every year during Chaitra Navratri to celebrate Shri Ram Navami. This year will be on April 9th Sat. and 10 Sunday 2016. Spring/ Basant Navratri

The beginning of spring and the beginning of autumn are considered to be important junctions of climatic and solar influences. These two periods are taken as sacred opportunities for the worship of the Divine Mother Durga. The dates of the festival are determined according to the lunar calendar. on which each women follow tradition to wear three colours of dress on Navaratri.

Navaratri represents a celebration of the Goddess Amba, (the Power). Navaratri or Navadurga Parva happens to be the most auspicious and unique period of devotional sadhanas and worship of Shakti (the sublime, ultimate, absolute creative energy) of the Divine conceptualized as the Mother Goddess-Durga, whose worship dates back to prehistoric times before the dawn of the Vedic age.

A whole chapter in the tenth mandal of the Rigveda addresses the devotional sadhanas of Shakti. The "Devi Sukta" and "Isha Sukta" of the Rigveda and "Ratri Sukta" of the Samveda similarly sing paeans of praise of sadhanas of Shakti. In fact, before the beginning of the legendary war between the Pandavas and Kauravas in the Mahabharata – a foundational Sanskrit epic in the Hindu tradition – Lord Krishna worshipped Durga, the Goddess of Shakti, for the victory of the Pandvas.

Lord Brahma is cited in the Markandey Purana as mentioning to Rishi Markandey that the first incarnation of Shakti was as Shailputri. Further incarnations of the Divine Mother are: Brahmacharini, Chandraghanta, Kushmanda, Skandamata, Katyayani, Kalaratri, Mahagauri and Siddhidatri in that order. These nine manifestations of Shakti, are worshipped as "Nava-Durga". The fifth chapter of the Rudra Samhita of Shiva Purana also vividly describes the various Divine Emanations of Durga.

Since the Vedic Age of the Rishies, the devotional practices recommended during Navaratri are primarily those of Gayatri Anushthana.

In the Vedic Age of the Indian Culture, the religious philosophy and devotional practices were focused towards true knowledge and ultimate realization of the supreme power of Gayatri (Bram Shakti). The Vedas were the basis of all streams of spirituality and science those days. Gayatri has been the source of the divine powers of the gods and goddesses in the heavens and their angelic manifestations and incarnations. Gayatri sadhana was also paramount in the higher level spiritual endeavors of the yogis and tapaswis. Gayatri Mantra was the core-focus of daily practice of sandhya-vandan (meditation and devotional worship) for everyone. As guided by the rishis, specific sadhanas and upasanas of the Gayatri Mantra were sincerely practiced during the festival period of Navaratri by every aspirant of spiritual enlightenment. This is mostly celebrated in ashoj or karthik.






