HSGC Executive Committee Meeting Minutes - March 2016

Date: Mar 6 2016, 10:30 AM- 12:30 PM Place: Cincinnati Temple

- Pooja committee chair presented upcoming important events
- ➤ Temple cultural committee head presented the ongoing activities for Mar 26 2016 Holi celebration events.
- ✓ Between May 20 and May 22, we will have the temple anniversary event, we need to advertise this event to all the communities and make it more prominent. Volunteers needed on May 19 for the preparation work.
- Pooja committee explained Priest expected duties to the new executive members and recommended the changes to improve overall operations.
- ✓ All the deities clothes needs to be changed every week.
- ✓ As part of cross training, all the priests should participate in conducting pujas for all deities; this will help in conducting the temple pujas, even when anyone of priest is on vacation or conducting outside puja.
- ✓ Puja committee head will discuss the changes with the priests.
- > Temple purchased the separate cabinets for the Hindu religious education services.
- Laxmi Srivastava discussed the need for raising membership and fund raising to address the temple building issues, Temple roof needs to be replaced. It is pending for long time.
- Executive committee approved \$1000.00 for lawn and landscaping project work for this spring.
- Nach Sitare and the Mela as well as Golf outing will be conducted in month of September for fund raising.
- ➤ Temple cultural committee head presented the ongoing activities for Mar 26 2016 Holi celebration events.
- ✓ Logistics arrangements were discussed, Bhavin is coordinating the efforts.
- > Mina Karamchandani submitted the Jan-Feb Income and expense report.
 - ✓ Income for Jan- Feb was \$42,494.27. The total expense was 78,933.63.
 - ✓ For the month of Jan and Feb the income is normal,
 Expenses exceeded the income due to following reasons.
 - 1. Bank charges reflect 2.75% fees to Paypal for credit cards use.
 - 2. Mela expense is carry-over from the last year.
 - 3. Office expense includes air ticket for outgoing priests.
 - 4. Property Tax: Instead of semi-annual, this year we paid the tax for the whole year.
 - 5. Repair and Maintenance Miscellaneous: includes certification for elevators, Bucknell heating and cooling service, and several repair works done by Paul Elliot
