Dear HSGC members, devotees, and temple supporters,

Warm greetings to you all! Hope all of you are doing well and enjoying the warm weather.

Your temple has been having a busy year. Our calendar has been very full with many activities and functions going on. . We had a very well attended Maha Shivratri in March. We had a packed house at the temple for Holi later in the same month. It was a fun-filled cultural program. We celebrated the temple's 19th anniversary on May 20th, 21st, and 22nd. It was followed by a first for our temple. The chief priest of our temple, Acharya Kailash Sharma presented a 3 day long Hari Katha session. It was a well-attended function and Kailash ji gave a very well received program full of insights from Ramayan, Mahabharat and Puranas accompanied by many bhajans. It was received very well by the devotees. We observed a children's day camp at the temple on July 11th. Over 50 children participated in the day long camp. It was thoroughly by all children. In addition, we have had several Mata Ki Chowki programs. These programs are always very well attended.

We have many important programs coming up now. These programs need considerable amount of planning. Some of the major events that are coming up include the August 15th celebration for Indian Independence Day. We are planning to have a kite flying festival to mark this occasion. We have the annual mela and Naach-Sitare event on Sept 17th. There is a tremendous excitement in the air for this event from the community already. We are also planning for the upcoming Golf tournament. It is a unique initiative by some temple devotees who are also golfing enthusiasts. Last year, the tournament was attended by 72 golfers. This year, the goal is to have participation from 120 golfers. This event proved to be a very good fundraiser for us and we are hoping that it will be even bigger this year.

We have initiated some major expansion for the temple. The devotee group of Umiya Mata and Kali maa are raising funds for expansion of the north wing of the temple. Devotees of Lord Murugan are planning for expansion of the south wing of the temple. We have drawn up plans for expansion of the front side of the temple that will facilitate entrance into the temple from the front door with facilities for coat hangers and shoe racks at the same level as well as rest rooms. We will be appealing to the entire devotee base for this expansion. I am confident that if we all come together, then this dream will become reality in no time.

A more important and more pressing issue for the temple is the maintenance of the temple building. The temple building is 20 years old now and we have seen a real need for a timely action. If we do not act right now, we may have to pay significantly more in a few years' time. We have estimated the total need for the maintenance to be \$100,000. I am urging all of you to donate generously to maintain this temple and preserve the hard work done by our predecessors. It is imperative that the whole community come together to complete this project well before the onset of winter.

We have a new priest at our temple now. Pundit Piyush Kumar Joshi has joined us now. He was previously with the temple at Macon, GA. We feel that he will prove to be a very valuable addition to the temple and the community. Please see his brief bio in this issue of Aradhana.

The temple needs more volunteers. We have many opportunities for volunteering, in big and small ways. If you are interested, please send us an email with your interest. Please remember that the temple belongs to all and it is our collective responsibility to sustain and grow this temple.

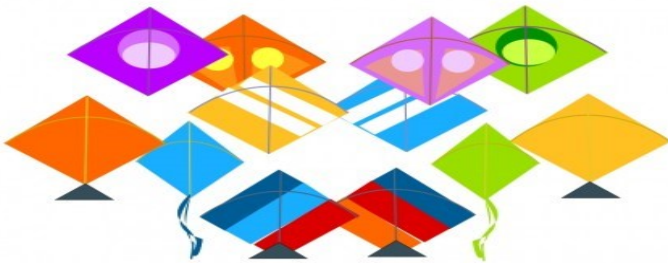

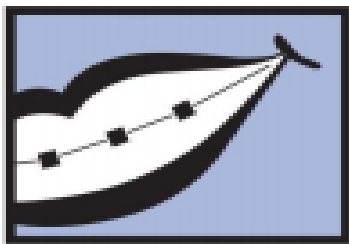
