(Taittiriya Upanishad, Krishna Yajur Veda) (by Koti Shrikrishna)

Bhrigu, son of Varuna, asked his father: "Dad, teach me about the Supreme."His dad said: – Think about That By which food, breath, eye, ear, mind, and speech are born. Having born with those we live, and to That we return—seek to know That. That is the Supreme."Bhrigu thought over and having thought over he concluded:



Meaning, my interpretation, if I may:


