

Mahatmya:

Every two and half years, the Hindu Calendar gets an additional one month. This extra month is called *Adhik Maas* in Sanskrit. Except Lord Vishnu, none of the Devas accepted or adopted this month. Hence Lord Vishnu or Lord Purushottam has been designated the Master of the month and the month is named after Him as Purushottam Maas. The Lord bestowed a boon on this month: whoever would perform religious activities, such as, attending Shrimad Bhagvat Katha, chanting Purushottam Sahasranaam Stotram, performing Yagya, puja, and numerous other good Karmas during this month will get ten times more *punyas* versus those deeds performed during normal months of the year. Therefore during this month in the entire Hindu world all kinds of religious activities are undertaken, including those in our temple.

What is Purushottam Sahasranaam Stotram?

Shrimad Vallabhacharya had two sons, Shri Gopinathaji and Shri Vitthalnathaji. Shri Gopinathaji had taken a ritual to read the entire Shrimad Bhagvat Path daily which would take four to five hours. The father became concerned and thought it was not practical and that he would have to find a better way. One day he came up with the 'perfect' solution. Shrimad Vallabhacharya picked and compiled in the poem form, one thousand (Sahasra) names of Lord Purushottam connected with His Avatars and Lilas from Shrimad Bhagvat Puran. The father then advised the son to chant this Purushottam Sahasranaam Stotram daily instead of chanting the entire Bhagvat Puran, and advised that by chanting all His Sahasra names hew ould remember all His Lilas and he would get the same fruit as by performing the Path. The son followed his father's advice. Let us chant it in our Temple at least on a weekly basis.

Dear HSGC Members/ Temple Devotees,

We are excited to announce a new *giving* program, which would help assure our temple's long term financial security not only for our generation but for our children and grandchildren's generation as well. 





BHAHUDA YATRA Sunday, 22 July 2018 - 10 am

Ratha Yatra or Chariot Festival is associated with Lord <u>Jagannath</u> held at <u>Puri</u> in the state of <u>Orrisha</u>, India. It is the oldest <u>Ratha Yatra</u> taking place in India and the World, whose descriptions can be found in Brahma Purana, Padma Purana, and Skanda Purana. This annual festival is celebrated on Ashadha Shukla Paksha Dwitiya (second day in bright fortnight of Ashadha month

The festival commemorates Jagannath's annual visit to <u>Gundicha Temple</u> via <u>Mausi Maa Temple</u> (aunt's home near Balagandi Chaka, <u>Puri</u>.

As part of Ratha Yatra, the deities of Jagannath,his elder brother <u>Balabhadra</u> and younger sister <u>Subhadra</u> are taken out in a procession to Gundicha Temple and remain there for nine days. They are also accompanied by Sudarshana chakra. Then the deities or Ratha Yatra return to the <u>Main temple</u>. The return journey of Puri Jagannath Ratha Jatra is known as Bahuda Jatra.

Three richly decorated <u>chariots</u>, resembling temple structures, are pulled through the streets of Puri called Badadanda. This commemorates the annual journey of Lord Jagannath, Lord Balabhadra, and their sister Subhadra to their aunt's temple, the <u>Gundicha Temple</u> which is situated at a distance of 2 km from their temple. This is the only day when devotees who are not allowed in the temple premises,

such as non-Hindus and foreigners, can get their glimpse of the deities. During the festival, devotees from all over the world go to Puri with an earnest desire to help pulling the Lords' chariots with the help of other priests pulling the chariots with ropes. They consider this auspicious deed and risk their lives in the huge crowd. The huge processions accompanying the chariots play devotional songs with drums, tambourines, trumpets etc. Children line the streets through which the chariot will pass and add to the mass chorus. The Ratha carts themselves are some approximately 45 feet (14 m) high and are pulled by the thousands of pilgrims who turn up for the event; the chariots are built a new each year only from a particular type of tree. Millions of devotees congregate at Puri for this annual event from all over the country and abroad.

Hindu Temple of greater Cincinnati celebrates Rath-Yatra each year during Rath Yatra festival time with great devotion. This year is scheduled on July 14thth Saturday 4pm, all releted rituals starts from privious day. Hundreds of devotees attend and volunteers to pull the Rath of Lord Jagannath while chanting, Dancing in temple boulward. Deties are kept and worshipped in Temple basement stage for 9 days and returned back to its orginal place upsatairs main Temple 9th day with great Bahuda Yatra celebration scheduled on July 22nd 10am.

Mahaprasad

"Sri Jagannath" - the literal meaning of His name is "the Lord of the Universe". He is worshipped by Hindus in regional traditions in Odisha (India). Sri Jagannath is considered a form of Lord Vishnu. He is part of the triad, trimurthy or "teeni thakura" along with his elder brother, Balabhadra, and his sister, Subhadra. The Holy Temple of Sri Jagannath is located in Puri, Odisha. It is believed that there are four holy shrines located around India at cardinal points including Puri, Dwarka, Badrinath, and Rameswaram. These four locations are believed to have been loved by Lord Vishnu intimately. It is presumed that Lord Vishnu takes his bath at Rameswaram, dines at Puri, meditates at Badrinath and relaxes at Dwarka. Hence, the Puri temple food is not only considered prasad, but is rather held to a more supreme importance. Included in this supreme food is the Mahaprasad presented to Lord Jagannath. It refers to the 56 items offered to Lord Jagannath in Puri during the day. This prasad gets its namesake because it is offered first to Lord Jagannath, and then to Goddess Vimla.



There are two types of Mahaprasad. Namely, Sankudi and Sukhila. Sankudi usually includes dishes such as plain rice, ghee rice, mixed rice, rice with cumin, hengu rice, ginger rice, sweet dal, plain dal, dalma (dal with many vegetables), mixed curries including mahura, besara, ghanta, rai, saga bhaja, khatta, and pithas (sweet cakes) of many types. These dishes are prepared by chefs, more affectionately known as Suaras. These men (around 700) cook enough of Mahaprasad to provide plenty in order to sell to devotees within the Temple. Sukhila Mahaprasad includes khaja, kakara, pheni gaja, ladoo, pitha puli, mantha puli, enduri, jhilli, and boondiya. The Mahaprasad is offered to the Lords 6 times during each day. In order, the offerings are called; Gopala Ballabha Bhoga (7 items), Sakala Dhupa (13 items), Bhoga Mandapa Bhogo, Madhyanha Dhupa (pithas), Sandhya Dhupa (mostly contains food items



requested by devotees), and lastly the Bada Simhara Bhoga. This food is offered to the Lords in a traditional, ritualistic manner.

As per traditions that have been followed by proud Odias for ages, the Holy Mahaprasad is always cooked in Earthen pots with firewood. This tradition, along with Mahalaxmi's blessings, feeds 20,000 people everyday (and up to 50,000 on special occasions!). A common belief regarding Mahaprasad is that it is never finished, regardless of the limited yield. This is widely considered to be a mahima of Lord Jagannath, as He would never let his devotees leave without a full stomach of the heavenly Mahaprasad.

As an Odia, being linked to the culture surrounding Sri Jagannath is an honor. The way the prasad is prepared is ultra-hygienic and also an out-of-thisworld science experiment; several gigantic earthen pots are stacked one upon another and cook simultaneously. This preparation is considered magical and a pillar of the culture of Odias. We strive to maintain these rich values and hope to continue our customs for eras, with the blessings of Lord Jagannath.






