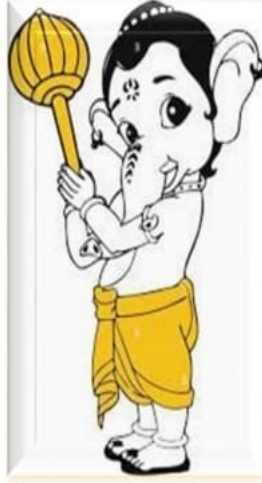

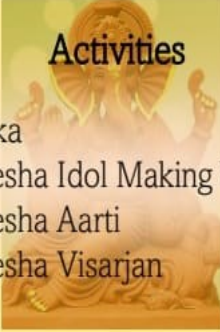

We are currently establishing something you are very familiar with at your schools: STUDENT GOVERNMENT.

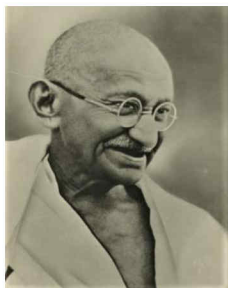
Students will get opportunities to:

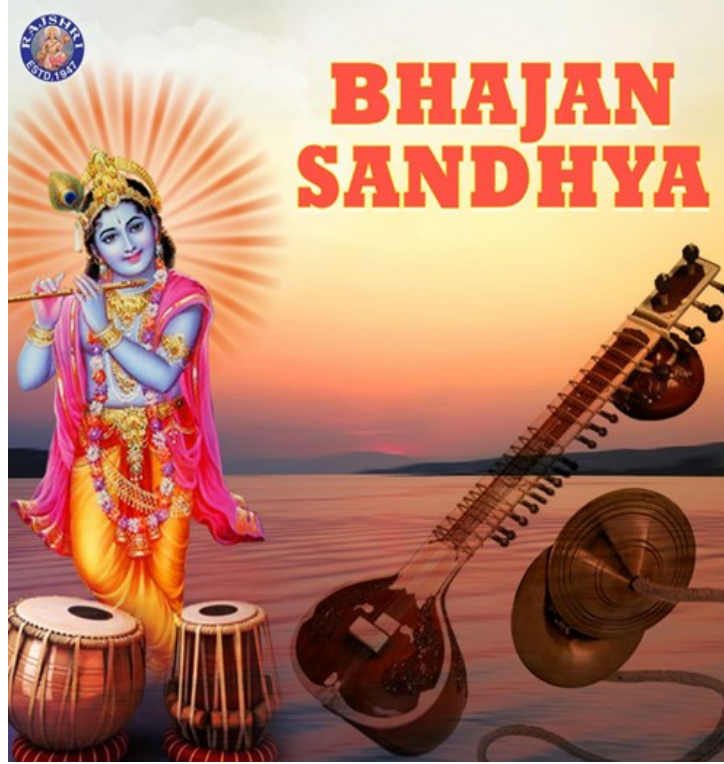
