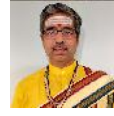

## **Holi - festival of colors**

Holi is a religious as well as social festival. It is celebrated on Phalgun Purnima. The next day is named Rang-Holi, the festival of colors. In the Vedic period, this festival was known as "Navatishṭa Yag". There was a tradition in society to accept, as the prasada from the yajna's havan, the grain that was partly cooked and partly raw. This very grain was called "hola", and hence the festival came to be known as Holi.

Holi is one of the prevalent festivals of Hindus. It is the festival of colors. It represents the triumph of goodness over evil. On this day people forget their feud and grudges and play Holi together.

Now the question is why is it celebrated?

There was a king named Hiranyakashap. He hated Lord Vishnu. He did a tough penance and pleased Lord Brahma. He wanted to be immortal. But Lord Brahma couldn't give such blessing to him. Lord Brahma told him to ask for another blessing. Then, Hiranyakashap asked to give another wish and obtained a boon that he couldn't be killed by any human or animal, inside or outside, in day or night, and no weapon could harm him. Therefore, feeling secure he started to trouble earth and heaven. He had a son named Prahlad who was a great devotee to Lord Vishnu. Hiranyakashap tried his best to get rid of his own son, but every time Lord Vishnu saved Prahlad. So, he called his sister Holika.

Holika had received a blanket from Lord Brahma which could save its owner from burning fire. She sat in the fire with Prahlad on her lap. Prahlad was chanting 'Om Bhagwate Vasudevay Namah'. Suddenly a storm came which replaced the blanket from Holika to Prahlad. And Holika got burned in the fire and died. Later Lord Narsimha (an incarnation of Lord Vishnu) killed Hiranyakashap at the threshold of the palace with his own paws in evening time.

The second reason is in Brij Bhumi Lord Krishna used to play Holi with Radha. It is one of the reasons that Holi is so famous in Vrindavan.

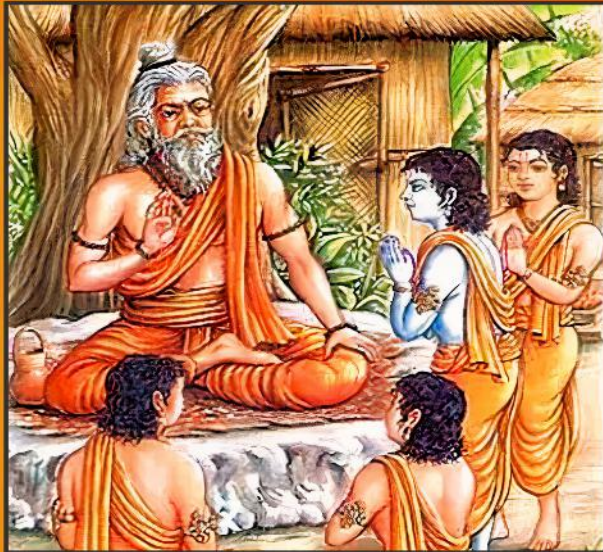
